A bit more on... One-on-One Conversations

We acknowledge that the thought of a one-on-one with someone in a Zoom breakout might bring out a mix of emotions. Maybe that's exciting for you or maybe that generates some nervousness or both! Know that that's totally okay; we've found that this activity is the highest rated in our 24+ retreats!

What it looks like:

• Your discussion group will be divided into pairs (for 8minutes) providing an opportunity for a short discussion.

The purpose:

- This gives you an opportunity to connect more personally to each of the attendees.

Tips:

- Ask questions that bring out the best in someone (vs. putting them on the spot in an uncomfortable way).
- Ask questions that you're really curious to know about.
- Read the Yearbook beforehand and talk about something specific based on what they shared about themselves.
