- Original Mind Time: Time to communicate with Heavenly Parent, write reflections. Time for nature.
- Service Community at Barlastone School: Barlastone
 School is owned by the Zambian Local Church. We will
 provide services such as Character Education, exchange
 of education program, library, etc.
- Service Community at <u>Barlastone</u> Church: This is our local church. Exchange with local youth, participate in cleaning the church, organizing a <u>one day</u> workshop.
- Service Community at the Clinic: Twikatane Clinic belongs to the local church. Currently not functioning. Provide help in renovation and medical equipment.
- Service Community at Zambia Hope: Zambia Hope is an NGO founded by Archbishop Emmanuel Milingo. He has a community school and community clinic. We will provide services at both facilities.
- Service Community at Mr. Cho's Farm: Mr. Cho is a Korean business missionary who has been helping the Zambian community in agriculture projects and oversea exposures.
- Twikatane Farm Factory: It is a factory run by the first missionaries sent to Zambia since 1975.
- Sataronno: Kafue and Victoria Falls. We shall discover how Great God is.
