Anyonghaseyo, dear brothers and sisters!

Here another inspiration, based on the words of True Father and Heung Jin Nim:

Heung Jin Nim: "Never stop giving your heart for the sake of others!" [1]

The real giving is the giving of the heart. Giving our heart may be easy when people are nice and kind to us. But it does not only apply in those cases. It also applies to people who are very irritating.

If we encounter such people we may easily end up arguing and fighting with them without end. We may accumulate resentment. It can be like a spiritual war.

That however is not God's way at all. It is the way of the fallen world, where small things can

cause endless fighting.

We certainly have to do better than that, if we want to be on God's side. We need to be respecting, loving, forgiving and embracing people where others would have given up a long time ago. Our love needs to be unchanging, under any circumstances, just as God's love is:

Heung Jin Nim: "Do not struggle with other people. I never antagonize others. I could probably fight with so many people because I can see evil in them. Instead, I take responsibility for them and love them. All I know is the Word, and that I should make the Word my own by living it. Then growth comes naturally." [2]

Indeed, it is easy to see the fallen nature in others. And then it might not take long before we criticise, judge, antagonize and blame them. And we might justify ourselves, thinking we "just want to help" them.

But they rightly do not perceive that as help, but feel forced, antagonized, offended and bullied. And then we are in the middle of a spiritual war, where nobody gives in. That certainly does not make our hearts grow. It rather robs us of our energy and pushes God and people away.

Instead of fighting with others, we need to become people who love everyone under any circumstances. And this love is not arguing, struggling or fighting with others. It is not antagonizing others, but respecting them, accepting them as they are, embracing them, loving them, unchangingly, unconditionally. Such love has to be our brand:

True Father: "We should discard everything having to do with the fallen world and return to the standard of our original mind. It means to return to our inner self. That is why Jesus said that the kingdom of God is within us. It means that unless we liberate the goodness in our heart, it will be impossible for us to realize an ideal world, a world of happiness." If we focus on loving the way God does, then our hearts become more and more mature. Fallen habits will fade away. Goodness will be liberated. And we will be able to create the Kingdom of God. We will become the true love movement that God urgently needs to get this world into His bosom. And we will be highly blessed, beyond our imagination!
