## True Father: God will follow us... Heavenly fortune will follow us

Anyonghaseyo, dear brothers and sisters!

Here again some inspiration, based on the words of True Father and Heung Jin Nim:

True Father: "When we sacrifice everything for the sake of absolute love, we can control God, the satanic world, and heavenly fortune. What do I mean by control? It means that God will follow us. God, this world and heavenly fortune will follow us." [1]

"Sacrificing everything" sounds like having to give all our possessions away. But making true love the center of our life is not just about giving money away, working harder, fasting more etc. It is rather about going forward in our heart, which is a much more internal thing:

Heung Jin Nim: "It is your job to go forward, and this is not just an external responsibility; it is not just obedience to Father's latest project. It is going forward in your hearts..." [2]

The real issue and our most important job is growing in heart and love. And that requires far more than just giving some possessions away or

doing much fasting and praying or the like. Those things may be good and necessary, but to really grow in heart we need to dig deeper.

What is the point of doing many "sacrifices", but then resenting people for what they have done to us or becoming self righteous? In that way we cannot become divine people. That is not the way to have true love at the center. That is not really living for others, no matter how many "activities" we do.

The path of true love is very internal, very invisible. It is about constantly checking our heart, our motivation. Are we trying to be a blessing to others? Are we thinking for the benefit of others? Are we speaking for the advantage of others, or are we trying to get something out of them? Or are we trying to make ourselves look good?

We need to constantly watch ourselves internally, our motivation, our thinking, our speaking and our acting. Are we focused on establishing true love in our life, unchanging, unconditional love for everyone, even the biggest sinner? Or are we sometimes or often trapped by self centered thoughts, possibly not even noticing it happening?

The more consciously we are focused on cultivating our heart, the more we grow in love, the more divine

we become. Advancing in heart weighs more than all the external things. In deed, all the external things will be much more fruitful, if we are focused on cultivating our heart.

The more we grow in heart, the more victories of love we can achieve. And God will be totally on our side, as True Father explains in the above quote. Achieving constant victories of love in our life makes our whole life a great success, and at the same time makes God, ourselves and others happy.

On that very internal path of growth of heart it is highly recommendable to ask True Father, Heung Jin Nim and Jesus for help and guidance:

Heung Jin Nim: "Just ask me to show you the way. Ask me to show you through the darkness of your own heart, through the barriers that you have there. I will help you." [3]

Such help is priceless, but at the same time free of charge.
