HJ Heaven and Earth CheonBo Training Center's 2022 Hyo Jeong Azalea Festival

The Family Month, May is a time when all creation is full of life and energy. On this occasion, Hyo Jeong Heaven and Earth CheonBo Training Center held the '2022 Hyo Jeong Azalea Festival' to convey the extreme love of Heavenly Parent and True Parents to the world. As we celebrated the 62nd Cosmic Holy Wedding Anniversary of True Parents of Heaven, Earth, and Humankind, we could feel Heavenly Parent's love and True Parents' blessing overflow in the training center, celebrating 'the joy of love,' as is the flower language of the azalea.

This year's Azalea Festival was held for 12 days from April 27 to May 8 and more than 13,000 people visited the training center. More than 1,200 church members from 27 churches in Region 1, including Junggu, Nowon, Songpa, CheonBok-gung, Gwanak, Incheon, Gangnam, Dongdaemun, and Jungrang came. Among them were nearly 100 new members, Peace Aewon members of UPF, and ambassadors for peace. On April 30, 100 members of the Sansuwon Patriotic Association of the Great Parish of Yeongdeungpo attended the Azalea Festival after taking part in a group education at the CheonBo Education Center. There was also a group reception from churches such as Osan and Yangyang in Region 2, Chanan, Jaecheon, Cheongju, and Okcheon in Region 3, Yeongam and Jeongeup in Region 4, and Daegu and Yeongcheon in Region 5. Furthermore, 80 students came from Sun Moon University and the Korean Language Institute of Sun Moon University and the Gangwon-do team of the 6000 Blessed Couples also participated. Below are the programs that took place centering on the Buheung Plaza's Azalea garden from 10:00 to 20:00 every day for 12 days.

Healing experience programs such as CheonBo Won exhibitions, 'Hyojeong Letter' to convey our gratitude to True Parents, Hyo Jeong MBT's mind and body healing with yoga, free Hanbok rental service, Buheung Plaza Booth, bubbles, photo contest, and magic performance were held every day.

The Hyo Jeong CheonBo Works Programs, including Hyo Jeong CheonBo Chanyang Session, Hyo Jeong Offering Ceremony, and Cheonshim Won Special Prayer Session was held on weekends and holidays (Children's Day, Parents' Day).

The schedule for church members, new members, and ambassadors for peace who participated during the weekdays consisted of a pilgrimage to Holy Grounds, the CheonBo Won exhibition, and education at the CheonBo Education Center. Then, they would enjoy the Buheung Plaza Booth, HeavenG Burger, Hyojeong Yeon, Hanwon House, and Daffodil [Suseonhwa] Bakery Café.

Those who participated in the Hyo Jeong Azalea Festival during the weekends and holidays were provided with a shuttle bus from the entrance gate of the Hyo Jeong Heaven and Earth CheonBo Training Center to the Buheung Plaza. Then they could go to the CheonBo Won, the Hanwon Path of Heavenly Fortune, the Cheonseung Dae, take part in the Hyo Jeong CheonBo Chanyang Session and Cheonshim Won Special Prayer Session, enjoy meals at the Buheung Plaza Booth, HeavenG Burger, or Hyojeong Yeon, or even gather at the Hanwon House or Hyojeong Café for tea.

Experiential Programs

Cheon Bo Won Exhibition

Cheon Bo Won was open for exhibition from 10:00 to 17:00 every day during the Azalea Festival. Participants could go and study the history of Cheon Bo providence and understand this era of the substantial Holy Spirit where True Mother takes direct dominion. All of the four halls were made available: True Parents' Providence of Restoration Hall, History of Cheon Bo Providence Hall, Heavenly Tribal Messiah Hall, and CheonBo Hall. Guidance in Korean was provided from 11:00 to 12:00 and 14:00 to 15:00 and guidance in Japanese was provided from 13:00 to 14:00. A guided tour was also provided to group visitors who made reservations in advance. Audio guidance was provided in three languages: Korean, Japanese, and English for participants who could not come in on time for the guided tour. Along with the exhibition of the Cheon Bo Won, the number of visits of ambassadors for peace and new members increased significantly.

According to the statistics of visitors to Cheon Bo Won from April 27 to May 8, there were a total of 1,726 visitors, including 40 ambassadors for peace from the Gangnam Church, 44 ambassadors for peace from the Okcheon Church, and 14 pilgrims from the Namwon Church.

The 'Hyojeong Letter,' an event to convey our heart of gratitude and hope to True Parents was held during the Azalea Festival. Visitors participated in the event by writing their message to True Parents on the letter sheet provided at the entrance of the Cheonshim Won Prayer Hall and then offered it, writing their names, affiliated church, and contact number.

More than 200 letters were turned in during the Azalea Festival. We are planning to award True Parents' portrait to the winner of the 1st grand prize, a framed quote True Parents' word to 3 gold award winners, and a souvenir from Buheung Department Store to 5 silver award winners.

Hyo Jeong MBT Center's mind and body healing with Yoga

From April 30 to May 8, a mind and body healing program was held at the Hyo Jeong MBT Center on the 6th floor of the Chinhwa Hall. Tickets were given out at the Hyojeong Booth by order of arrival and the applicants took part wearing comfortable outfits and facemasks.

Among the two programs that were rolled, the first was the Hyojeong ring and the Hyojeong ball program. The Hyojeong ring helps you obtain a higher yoga effect when you apply it on your shoulder,

waist, or calf. The Hyojeong ball is used for meditation because its unique sound and echo create a harmony of vibration.

Through this program, the many shared that they were able to recover from their exhaustion and refresh their minds and body as well as experience inner growth. The second program was a walk to the Hanwon Path of Heavenly Fortune. Those who took part could experience healing.

Free Hanbok rental service

A free Hanbok rental service was provided at the Buheung Plaza and the Hyo Jeong Photo Studio on the 2nd floor of the Chinhwa Hall from 10:00 to 17:30.

It was a service allowing families to borrow Hanbok for an hour. Those who took part in the experience could feel as if they were on a trip to a traditional Korean Village and setting. It also provided foreign students from Sun Moon University and the Korean Language Institute of the SunHak UP Graduate University the opportunity to experience traditional Korean culture.

The most popular trail was the route with the Hanwon House in the background, One of the students of the SunHak UP Graduate School Korean Language Institute S.T (second generation blessed family, female) said she was able to experience real Korean culture through the Hanbok service during the Azalea Festival. "I was grateful for this opportunity to share Heavenly Parent's love with my beloved sisters. I came to Korea as a student because I wanted to learn more about Heavenly Parent and True Parents. The Korean culture is the culture of Cheon II Guk. I was able to experience real Korean culture by trying out Hanbok and taking pictures.

CheonBo Great Works Programs

Weekends and Holidays (Children's Day, Parents' Day) The Hyo Jeong CheonBo Chanyang Session was held at the Main Hall of the Cheonseong Wanglim Palace from 14:00 on weekends and holidays during the Azalea Festival (Children's Day and Parents' Day), The training center staff took turns in emceeing, offering prayer, and performing as the Chanyang team. A total of five Chanyang Sessions were conducted with more than 3,000 participants.

The manager of the Korean training team Juhwan Kim announced the opening of the Hyojeong Offering Ceremony and the director of education Inseong Moon offered a representative prayer.
