SUMMER SUBREGIONAL HIGHLIGHTS




Sub Region 1: Northeast

The theme of the conference was the reunification of the Korean peninsula, a central focus in Father and Mother Moon's work for peace. The conference endeavored to answer the question, how can the young people of three nations contribute to the peaceful reunification of the Korean peninsula? The situation of Korea was thoroughly explained by three of our elder educators from each country: Dr. Thomas Ward, President of Unification Theological Seminary, Rev. Sang Pil Moon, Cheon Won

Block Leader for Youth in Korea, and Katsumichi Motoyama, President of CARP Japan. We also had a presentation by a representative student from each nation about the activities they hosted to bring awareness and change to the situation in Korea.
