  - We HIGHLY encourage you to get a COVID test (rapid, PCR,

home) before coming. Please stay home if you or someone you've been in contact with recently are experiencing any symptoms or tested positive.

- 2. If you are arriving only on Sunday for the Sub Regional Sunday Service, the service will begin at 11 AM in the Dojo. The overflow room is on the 2nd floor in Lecture Hall 1.

### **COVID Protocol for BCSF XVII**

Due to the different COVID variants and mutations, we have decided to enforce some rules here at BCSF for the in person portion. We want everyone to have an amazing experience and to do that safely.

Please adhere to what is stated below:

Before arrival, we highly encourage you to get tested for COVID - PCR, rapid, or home test. The more people that do this, the better, even if you are vaccinated. We understand that this may be difficult for people to do since our weekend starts tomorrow. It is not a mandatory measure, but in order to help prevent the spread of COVID, we encourage everyone to do so before arriving.

Once you arrive to UTS:

- Enter in the front entrance. No cars will be allowed to enter through the back road.
- Our staff will meet you at the gate of UTS. We will be checking your temperature with a temperature gun while you are still in your car. Once everyone in the car has been passed, you can proceed to parking.
  - Please note that if one or more people do not pass a temperature check, you will not be allowed to enter UTS.
- Please park in the designated area past the soccer field.
- Once you have parked, head to the registration tables outside near the community tents where the Village normally is. At registration, you will be asked to sign a Liability Waiver. This is to ensure that we are on the same page and working together to keep people safe.
- Please wear a mask. Vaccinated or not, we will be asking everyone to wear a mask, inside and outside, except when you are playing sports.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be readily available. Please use them often.

Failure to adhere to these guidelines will lead to being asked to leave the property and BCSF immediately.
