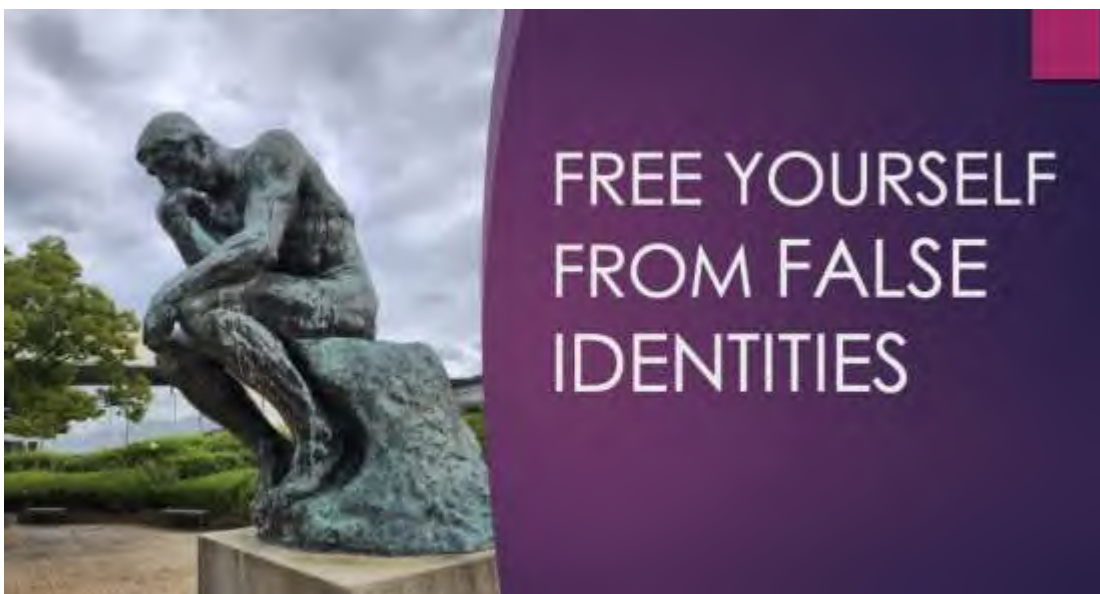
Hello,

I (Richard Panzer) started last Sunday's sermon honoring fallen soldiers in advance of Memorial Day, by sharing 2 videos from the REDEDICATE 250 event that took place on May 10 at the Washington Monument, including the talk by the actor Jonathan Roumie, who played the role of Jesus in the Chosen and Secretary of State Marco Rubio, House Speaker Mike Douglas, Dr. Alveda King, the niece of Martin Luther King, Jr., and Dr. Ben Carson.

I was very moved by Shigeru's sermon on 5/10, how he realized that watching porn was not aligned with his true identity. He felt trapped, like he would never be able to escape it. He'd kept that as a secret which is what Satan wants, all of us alone and fearful with secrets. But he discovered a new identity in Christ.

Shigeru's testimony led me to think about the issue of identity and how important this is. Genesis chapter 3 describes how Adam and Eve were deceived about who they really were. So, let's read the beginning of Genesis 3. I have to admit that Lucifer knows how to BS very persuasively! He would have made a good used car salesman!

Now the serpent was more crafty than any other beast of the field that the Lord God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God actually say, 'You shall not eat of any tree in the garden'?" And the woman said to the serpent, "We may eat of the fruit of the trees in the garden, but God said, 'You shall not eat of the fruit of the tree that is in the midst of the garden, neither shall you touch it, lest you die.'" But the serpent said to the woman, "You will not surely die. For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." Genesis 3:1-5

Traditional Christian theology teaches that the penalty for disobeying God's commandment was death. Would any of the parents here give the death penalty to your children for violating your directions? Is the love you have for your children greater than God's love for His children? This makes no sense. Rev. Sun

Myung Moon clarified that God gave the commandment not as a threat, but rather as a warning to PROTECT his children from misusing something very powerful. When parents shout at their children not to run out into the street, it's not a threat, it's a warning. Right?

Some critics say that Adam and Eve chose freedom and consciousness by disobeying God's commandment. Do you think that's true? No, they chose confusion, separation and mistrust. That's not enlightenment. It was hell.

For Eve it was not just a question about what God said. Lucifer was saying that God couldn't be trusted, that he was hiding something from her. He was saying maybe God doesn't really care about you! Aren't there times when the disparity between current reality and what God's words say is confusing? When God seems very far away? That's how Eve felt. The truth is she was pushing God away. She forgot her identity.

If Eve was clear about her identity not only as the beloved daughter of God, the future mother of a family, and also the founding Queen of a civilization, she wouldn't have had sexual intimacy with the spirit being Lucifer. If Adam was clear about his identity, he would have led his future wife and protected her.

Of course they did the very thing God warned them about. When they hid from God and couldn't honestly take responsibility, then God had no basis to talk to them. They had inherited Lucifer's nature. They came to have shame, guilt and fear, which is what we have inherited.



God isn't interested in hearing us repeatedly say how sorry we are. If your child does something wrong, do you want him to walk around feeling guilty weeks or months? Or do you want him or her to clearly understand WHY what they did was wrong and choose not to do it again. When we honestly report what we did and think and where we are, without making excuses, He can begin to guide us.

The reason people waste their time doing pointless or self-destructive things is because they don't know their identity! When Jesus met the Samaritan woman at the well (John 4:1-42), he didn't dwell on the fact that she had had 5 husbands and was living with a man she wasn't married to. He said come to ME, I have the living water you need. I AM the living water you need. And God used the woman who was used and abused and looked down upon to evangelize the entire town.

Is your identity shame, fear, or guilt? Do you think "I'm not important." "No one cares whether I live or die?" Are you doing self-destructive things because you think you're unworthy? Where did that spirit of unworthiness come from? We need to understand that we are surrounded by spirits all the time. We need to be VERY careful about which ones have taken up residence in our minds. When that low spirit is kicked out, the other stuff will go away. Then you'll do what you're supposed to be doing, what fills you with joy and pride, you won't have time to do useless things.

If you ask God, "what do you think of me?" I doubt he will say anything about all the wrong things you have done. I think He would say, "you are beloved."

If something is troubling you, report to God and Jesus what you did, tell them the struggling thoughts you have. Then Jesus will say let me have that trash pile, the trash pile of fear, guilt and shame. Jesus is the garbage collector who takes all that satanic trash away,

The Opposite of shame is honor

The Opposite of fear is power.

The Opposite of guilt is innocent.

Christ makes us honorable, innocent, and powerful. As it says in 2 Timothy 1:7, “For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.”

Fill up your mind with the words of God and Christ every day, otherwise the lies and low spirits will flood back in.

We are meant to reflect the image of our Creator. The reason Jesus and True Father’s words are so important is that we can absorb from them how God thinks, how someone who embodies God’s mind and heart understands reality.
