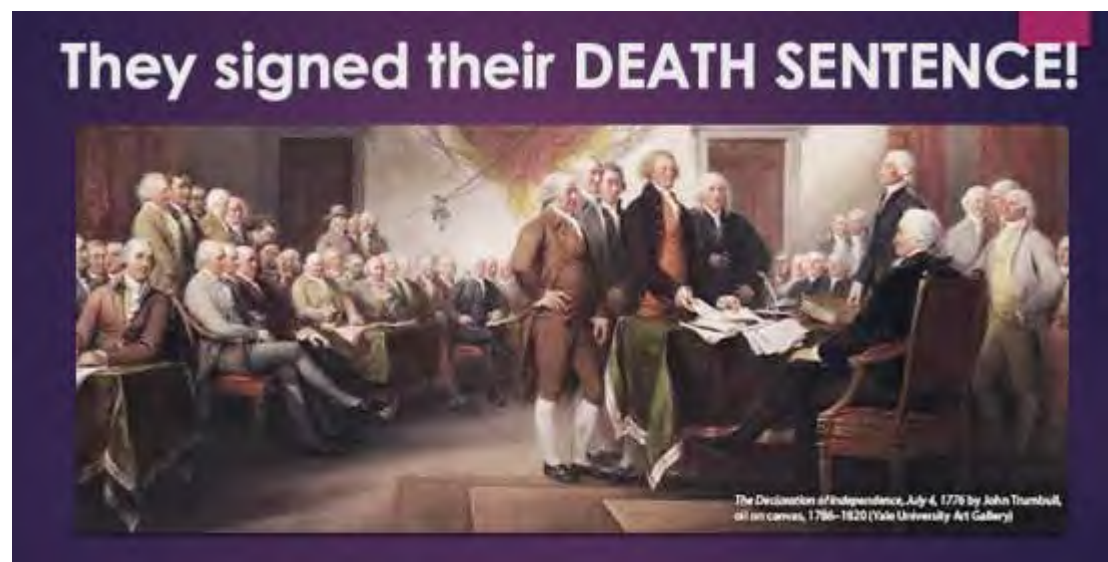

Hello,

I (Richard Panzer) started the sermon at the Newfoundland Sanctuary Church, by discussing how according to the Divine Principle, God's providence has been to prepare a nation that could welcome the Messiah and assist the establishment of the 3 Blessings in that nation and throughout the world. A nation that won't kill the Messiah, that protects freedom of speech and of religion. That encourages strong families and a Godly culture. That allows individuals and families to fulfill the 3rd blessing by keeping and passing on the fruits of their efforts to future generations.

"We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator, with certain unalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness."

The founding document of America spoke not only about grievances against King George, but more importantly about its ideals. The birth of the USA was unique in that its founders proclaimed the idea of unalienable, God-given rights that could not be taken away by government without due process in a court of law.

21 years earlier, in 1755, during the French and Indian War, 23-year-old Colonel Washington was one of 1,400 British troops under the command of General Braddock. They were marching to capture Fort Duquesne near Pittsburgh when a French and Indian force attacked them. During the battle, "Braddock

was killed, and every officer on horseback was shot, except Washington.” The young colonel later wrote to his brother,



"But by the All-Powerful Dispensations of Providence, I have been protected beyond all human probability or expectation; for I had four bullets through my coat, and two horses shot under me, yet escaped unhurt, although death was leveling my companions on every side of me."

A Native American who fought in the battle later stated, "Washington was never born to be killed by a bullet! I had seventeen fair fires at him with my rifle and, after all, could not bring him to the ground."

On July 4, 1776, the 56 signers of the Declaration were signing their death sentence. While none were executed by the British, five were captured, nine died from wartime hardships, and at least 17 lost their homes or fortunes. Many suffered deep financial ruin, while others survived to build successful political careers in the new republic.

Richard Stockton (New Jersey): Captured by Loyalists and imprisoned in harsh conditions. He was released early but died in poverty in 1781. **Francis Lewis (New York):** His home was destroyed and his wife was imprisoned for months by the British, dying shortly after her release. **John Hart (New Jersey):** Forced to flee into forests and caves while his wife was dying and his mill was destroyed by the British. **Thomas Nelson Jr. (Virginia):** Allowed American forces to fire on his own home (which the British were using as a headquarters). He later died deeply in debt.

I then showed a video called George Washington's Immortals: The 400 Who Saved the American Army (youtu.be/a4T-sywgeis?si=96yVSXtzl40QgTly). It shows the struggle and sacrifice of the soldiers, most of whom were farmers or craftsmen, who fought against the professional fighters of the most powerful Empire in the world. So what were they fighting for? Of course independence from England, but not just that. They sought to create a new kind of nation based on the idea of God-given rights. Unfortunately, it would take many decades to apply it all Americans.

America's history includes a struggle to confront the moral evil of slavery. It would take 8 decades from the founding to abolish the institution of slavery in America. Here is an anti-slavery pamphlet written in 1700. Individual states did take action to ban it, during the Revolutionary War and soon after. Vermont banned slavery in 1777. Massachusetts banned slavery in 1780. Pennsylvania 1780. New Hampshire 1783. Connecticut & Rhode Island 1783. New York 1799. New Jersey 1804.

The economist Thomas Sowell wrote the following:

While slavery was common to all civilizations, as well as to peoples considered uncivilized, only one civilization developed a moral revulsion against it, very late in its history—Western civilization. Today it seems so obvious that, as Abraham Lincoln said, "If slavery is not wrong, nothing is wrong." But the hard fact is that, for thousands of years, slavery was simply not an issue, even among the great religious thinkers or moral philosophers of civilizations around the world.

And that one civilization that banned slavery was the Judeo-Christian civilization in Great Britain, Europe and America, based on Biblical teachings.



But in 2026, as we all know, America is very divided. Many young people have turned towards Socialism. Zohran Mandami, a Muslim socialist, became Mayor of NYC this year. Just last week, radical candidates he endorsed from Democratic Socialists of America won the Democratic nominations for Congress in NYC and Colorado.

After this 250th American anniversary, will it embrace a socialist future? The DSA platform promises free healthcare, public housing, free college education. People need to realize the state that provides everything for you also controls you. It's the creation of an all-powerful state, as Kook Jin Nim puts it, the Rule of the ArchAngel.

DSA representatives fully embrace the Marxist attack on the family. Let's take a look at what they say: "Socialist analysis makes clear that the nuclear family form (parents with children) is an inherently repressive, racist and hetero-sexist institution that functionally reinforces and reproduces capitalism." **The things the family normally provides—food, housing, education, and childcare—would be "collectivized."** meaning those things would be taken over by the government.

Here is another quote: "the only real difference between marriage and prostitution is the price and duration of the contract." It sounds like they don't want men and women to get married. Then who takes care of the children?

The Socialist view is that "Your Children Belong to the State."

The good news is that these are just a few radicals who will represent NY and Colorado at Congress. The bad news is that radicals have taken control of the Democrat party and if they win in the Midterms they will give President Trump and our country a lot of headaches.

On a more hopeful side, we also see a rise in religious attendance among young men in the U.S. Here is what [Gallup polls reported](#):

Driven by a recent increase, young men in the U.S. have now surpassed young women in saying religion is "very important" in their lives. Gallup's latest data, from 2024-2025, show 42% of young men saying

religion is very important to them, up sharply from 28% in 2022-2023. By contrast, during this period, young women’s attachment to religion has held steady at about 30%.

Maybe if men rise to take leadership in their own lives and homes, the women will follow? Sisters, would you like to see that?

There has been a decrease in the birth rate in America and many countries all over the world. The main thing that affects people's desire to have children is their faith. If you care about the future of America, I would pray for a religious revival.
