## Barrytown College to Open Undergraduate Program at Unification Theological Seminary

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## Greetings!

More than 14 years ago, Rev. Sun Myung Moon, our True Father, spoke about creating an undergraduate college at the Unification Theological Seminary (UTS) in Barrytown and prayed on the shores of the Hudson River many times for the future leaders who would be educated there.

Thanks to the strong leadership of our national pastor, Rev. In Jin Moon, and her deep concern to embrace second-generation Unificationists and guide them to aim for excellence, this dream of establishing an undergraduate college in Barrytown is rushing towards fulfillment, with a scheduled opening in the fall of this year.

Founded in 1975, Unification Theological Seminary in 1986 was approved to offer accredited Master of Religious Education and Master of Divinity degrees and has since then been approved to offer a Masters of Arts in Religious Studies and a Doctor of Ministry degree as well.

Barrytown College on the Hudson (BCH) will offer rigorous academic study in a spiritually enriching environment in which students can dive into their interests and passions and discover their unique abilities to serve the world.



Barrytown College includes accomodations that can eventually house about 225 students.

The Bachelor of Arts degree will feature a Leadership and Management concentration for all students, a student orientation that emphasizes healthy relationships and marriage preparation, a World Religions and Philosophy major, which includes core courses such as "The Examined Life" and "Great Minds of East and West," and minors in Media Arts, Business and Human Development/Family Studies. Based on the level of student interest and approval by the New York Education Department, these minors will be expanded into majors by the third year. We will also establish partnerships with nearby colleges offering majors not offered at BCH.

Students at BCH will participate in a wide range of extracurricular projects: clubs and organizations, athletics, internships, advocacy projects, study abroad, work study, service learning projects, as well as a Capstone Project that culminates in the student's senior year and that can serve as a launching pad for a future career, or advanced studies. We hope to have 30 students or more enroll in the undergraduate program for the first year and for that number to expand in the following years, eventually reaching UTS's Main Building and Massena House maximum capacity of approximately 250 students.

The main building in Barrytown is in the process of receiving a long-overdue "makeover." Renovations

include building a new campus entrance, which will be a new visitor's center added to the East Wing near the soccer field and new pathways linking the East and West wings, among numerous other changes.

The costs to attend BCH will be those of a lower-priced private college: \$24,000 for tuition and \$8,600 for room, board and fees. Unificationists who are accepted will be awarded a \$12,000 scholarship and a refund if they have made an initial deposit at another college. Federal loans, work study and grants, which average \$15,500 for students from low- and middle-income families, will also be available. Applicants residing in New York state will also have access to New York Tuition Assistance Program funding.

Several prospective Unificationist students have said they are excited to see our church develop a college with high academic standards at which they can openly pursue their lives of faith. The number of classes we offer may initially be limited compared to other colleges, but in terms of quality of the faculty and courses, we intend to be in the same league as that of the best.

One of the two new faculty hired to support the undergraduate program is the Dean of Barrytown College, Dr. Stephen Butley Murray, who earned his B.A. in philosophy and religion from Bucknell University, a M.Div. from Yale University Divinity School, and a M.Phil. and Ph.D. in systematic theology from the Union Theological Seminary in New York City. The second new faculty is Dr. Donna Ferrantello, who will serve as Professor of English Literature. Dr. Ferrantello, a Fullbright Specialist scholar, earned her B.A. in Psychology at the University of Connecticut and a Doctorate in Theology at Drew University. Additional faculty will be hired over the next few years, as the number of students who enroll increases.
