First Organizational Committee Meeting for the HJ Cheonwon Central City Project

The inaugural organizational committee meeting for the Hyojeong Cheonwon Heavenly Central City Project was held on May 12 in the main hall of the Chinhwa B Education Center at the HJ Heaven and Earth CheonBo Training Center. Some 230 people attended, including leaders and senior staffers of providential organizations.

The meeting began with a formal opening by MC Director Kim In-chang of the Cheon Mu Won Central Administration Policy Office, and bouquets of flowers were presented by the committee task force Director Kim Jae-hyun, and Deputy Director Jung Jun-ah.

Chief Director of the Central Administration Lee Cheong-woo emphasized in his opening remarks that "Hyojeong Cheon Won will develop far beyond being a simple residential community to become a model city that substantially embodies the ideals of interdependence, mutual prosperity, and universal values. It will serve as an important base presenting an ideal example of life by which people attend Heavenly Parent substantially." Through this, he clearly presented the vision of Hyojeong Cheonwon.

President of FFWPU Heavenly Korea Rev. Hwangbo Guk offered a heartfelt prayer of gratitude. He reflected on the profound significance of Hyojeong Cheonwon, which lies at the heart of the new era, opened by True Mother through the Cheon Won Gung Cheonil Sanctum Entrance Ceremony. With deep sincerity, he prayed for the success of the project.

During the meeting, the organizational committee structure, roles of the various personnel, phased business promotion schedule, community culture formation, and plans for each institution's contribution were shared. In particular, practical tasks to be worked on within the next six months were announced including the development of religious tourism sites, job creation, and Family Federation welfare programs.

Subsequently, certificates of appointment were presented to the members of the organizing committee entrusted with leading the project: Kim Jong-gwan, Lee Gi-seong, Hwangbo Guk, Yoo Gyeong-deuk, Yoo Gwang-hyun, and Kim In-chang. Participants offered a solemn pledge to unite with Cheon Mu Won under True Mother's leadership. They committed to ensuring that all churches, organizations, and

businesses work together to strengthen the foundation of Hyojeong Cheonwon that will become the heavenly central city, and ensure its stable establishment.

Meanwhile, this project plans to develop Hyojeong Cheonwon as a community in which to live while serving Heavenly Parent. This includes establishing an infrastructure that includes the development of religious tourism sites and the expansion of residential communities within the Hyojeong Cheonwon area.

Once the community has developed it will serve as a global model for other communities worldwide. The committee plans to start immediately with drawing up practical plans and move forward quickly with the task of establishing detailed implementation plans for each task force.

The goal is to develop a living culture of Cheon II Guk where people live with Heavenly Parent substantially, and create a complex cultural space, establishing a city that offers a new way of life that everyone feels comfortable with–not just a space for the faith community alone.

This meeting was a strong first step announcing the substantial realization and leap forward toward the Cheon Il Guk ideal. The project aims to deliver solutions to the issues of reunification and peace on the Korean Peninsula and the entire world–currently torn by conflict and division–building a foundation for a global society where all people enjoy living together.
