Since we started to hold the two-days workshop last November, we had seen how things are moving so we could hold it every month. European Leadership Conference Seoul, Korea, February 14th - 18th, 2010



On Sunday February 14th, the first day of the Lunar calendar, around 60 participants gathered at the Provista Hotel in central Seoul for an opening dinner in a unique ELC programme. Until now all ELC programmes have been held at various locations in Europe, but this was the first to be held outside the region. Another interesting aspect of the programme was the make up of the participants, most of them came as couples to participate in the Blessing on February 17th at the Kintex Centre. They included members of Parliament from the Balkans region to a very spiritual couple from the United Kingdom and a member of the armed forces of the Netherlands. Also included were several newly matched couples.

The main programme was held at a conference room in Chungshin Village, formerly known as Silvertown, in Cheong Pyeong. The ELC program was managed by Heiner

Handschin with Fritz Piepenburg serving as the MC and lecture presentations given by Jack Corley. Being in the environment of Cheong Pyeong made a great impact on the spirit of the programme. Between the lectures there was an opportunity to sightsee around the campus. This experience left a deep impression on the participants, as they could see the substantial result of the ideals under discussion. During a visit to the hospital one couple experienced a distinct sense of healing as they entered the lobby and felt that anyone staying there could be cured of illness. Several were moved to see the tree in front of the Choon Jung Goon Palace, where Father tearfully prayed many years earlier. It helped them to get a sense of the history of our Movement and the visionary nature of True Father.

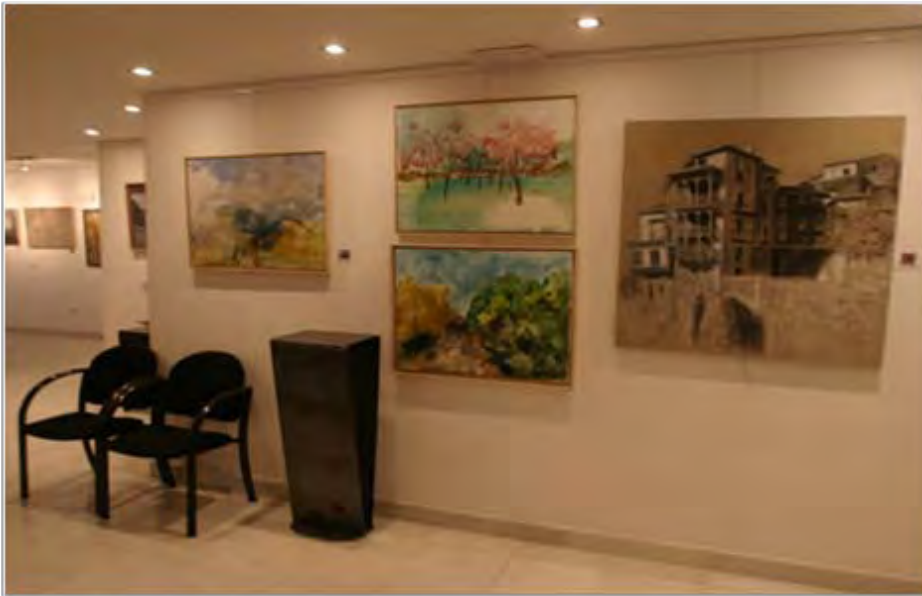

Sharing love between our city's faiths

IT HAS been 19 long years since Patricia Earle first arrived in Birmingham.

From an early age she has been inspired by the idea of helping people resolve their conflicts and make friends with their neighbours. She brought that vision to the city and has not looked back.

The Women's Peace Group began in Patricia's living room with just a few friends. They met once a month to pray for conflicts around the world and to learn about what women go through when they are trying to survive in a war zone or where a lack of basic rights makes life difficult.

Since then, Patricia's house has had to be extended twice to make room for the dozens of women who have joined the group.

"The highest attendance we have had was 120, and we regularly see 90-100 women at our events – at times we have women of up to

40 different nationalities present," says Patricia, aged 57.

In the early days, the group saw Christians from various local churches attending, but very soon Hindu, Sikh, Muslim, Jewish and Buddhist women friends were invited to come along. Together they began to share their different faiths and found lots of common ground.

"Peace, neighbourliness and hospitality are key concepts in all our religions," says Patricia. "So learning about each other's beliefs brought us closer together. We centre on our common humanity and desire for peace."

Meetings regularly involve guest speakers from areas of conflict across the globe and women are inspired to follow their progress and help in practical ways.

The Peace Women's key annual event is their Bridge of Peace ceremony, where women walk through a floral arch in pairs, picked at random, and pledge friendship to one another

and to each other's families and communities.

Exciting projects have been consistent with the aim of reaching out in love and friendship. So 12 years ago the group founded an orphanage in Hyderabad, India, which now has the capacity to house 40 children. Those who leave are helped to find jobs and accommodation, and often come back to visit.

Women from the Peace Group spent four years sewing a Peace Tapestry to be a symbol of religious harmony in Birmingham.

The tapestry, which was displayed at the

Town Hall before touring local places of worship, shows places of spiritual importance to local people, including a mosque, a church, a gurdwara, Hindu and Buddhist temples, a synagogue – and the Botanical Gardens.

Community cohesion is work that women do well, Patricia believes.

"Peace Women can inspire whole communities to work for peace, respect, equal rights and freedom for all," she said.

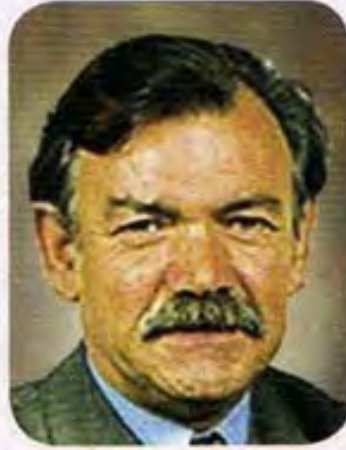

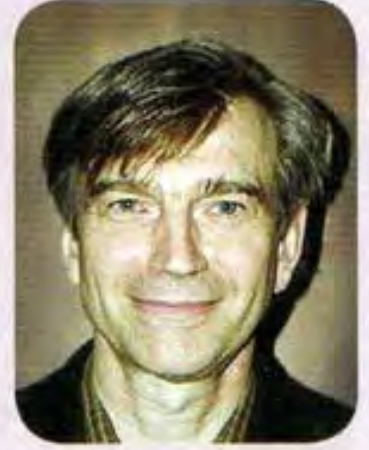
