December European Seven-Day Divine Principle Workshop

We had seven excellent guests on the seven-day workshop in Chislehurst this December (2-8) and several other members joining us. All our guests were women, and maybe because it was a small group, the experience for all was very deep. Some had known the Movement for a long time but had never studied this deeply; one girl from Germany just met CARP in Bucharest, Romania, two months ago. Here is a transcript of their final reflections (edited for corrections) to give you a taste of how the spirit is moving!

Final Reflections written by participants

"A taste of heaven - everyone tapped into everyone else's reservoir of love. At the end it was as though we'd known each other all our lives.

One little hiccup though when a discussion became a bit of a tug-of-war about whether the cross should be considered as an 'instrument of torture' and therefore not being worthy to be the Christian symbol of faith, or whether it should be considered the instrument of our salvation - eventually after much ego-bashing and swallowing of pride the two sides actually found it possible to give each other a reconciliatory hug.

The life-giving realization I have come to is that the collective love I've experienced in the warm cocoon of the Divine Principle workshop, can be just as easily [created] in the 'market place' of the world outside - if we gave just as much time to give to anyone we encounter and find out the goodness within, and be willing to enjoy their quirks and idiosyncrasies as much as their divine traits.

Also, that no matter how many times I hear the Divine Principle teaching and Sunday sermons - there's always some precious nugget to be mined and added to the treasure chest.

What I resolve to do now is to continue trying to live for the sake of others, with renewed consciousness of God's constant supervision."

"I am very grateful to have had this workshop. It's a very precious moment. I am not aware of what it is like being in Paradise, but this seven-days Divine Principle workshop suddenly gave me that paradise feeling, the feeling of being re-born once again.
