The Third International Conference of Hyojeong Academy

Organized by Hyojeong Academy and cosponsored by Sun Moon University, Sunhak UPA, Sunhak Academy, Cheongshim Academy, Unification Thought Institute, World Peace Professors Association, Family Federation for World Peace and Unification, and Hyojeong Magnolia Medical Foundation, the 3rd International Conference of Hyojeong Academy was held online. It saw the participation of 230 people from 15 countries, including Korea, Japan, and Taiwan, from January 1 to 3, 2024.

The conference featured 35 academic presentations on topics such as Coexistence, Co-prosperity, and Public Righteousness (24 papers), Unification Medicine (5 papers), and Peace and Unification Thought (6 papers).



During this period, papers like "What is the ideal Seonghwa" by Toru Hosoda of Hamorebi Clinic, Japan, "Identification of activity and structural review of the CYP106A family using cortisol" by Ki-Hwa Kim and Oh Tae Jin of Sun Moon University, Korea, "Acupuncture for Allergic Rhinitis" by Shawheen Alavi-Moghaddam and Sanghyun Lee of Wongu University of Oriental Medicine, USA, and "Can We Formulate a Religion Based on Science and Vice-versa?" by Dr. Lalit Mohan Kukreja, and "An overview of recent

environmental disasters due to anthropogenic climate change and its economic impact" by Detty Alappatt Pathrose of Epi Knowledge Foundation, India, received significant attention.



Meanwhile, with over 40% of the participants under the age of 43, the International Conference of Hyojeong Academy is expected to play a pivotal role in nurturing young scholars, focusing on the second generation for the future development of talent. The sponsoring organizations, including Hyojeong Academy, expressed their commitment to encourage the active participation of young scholars, particularly those of the second generation, and to build a body of God-centered academic work essential for the realization of

Cheon Il Guk. They also announced that the 4th International Conference of Hyojeong Academy, scheduled for August 22 to 24, will feature around 100 academic paper presentations.
