

# God's Providence Has Changed to a Backup Plan, Again

## Key Points:

1. John the Baptist's failure to follow and support Jesus ultimately led to the failure of the central providence of God at the time of Jesus.
2. Jesus had been preaching the Kingdom of Heaven on earth, but suddenly changed to reveal his death on the cross and resurrection (Matt. 16:21 From that time on...).
3. Jesus said that since John the Baptist, the Kingdom of Heaven was suffering attack and violence (Matt. 11:12).
4. Peter and the other disciples were surprised and did not accept what Jesus was saying... namely that God's Providence had changed (Matt. 16:23 and Mark 8:33).
5. God's secondary providence meant tremendous suffering for the faithful, including crucifixions and being eaten by lions (Luke 23:28).
6. Similarly, the failure of key followers of True Father has led to a change in God's Providence.
7. True Father's foundation for the Kingdom has suffered tremendously. Rev. Kwak/Preston Moon took away \$1 billion, many members, many businesses, and large amounts of property. Hyo Nam Kim (aka Dae Mo Nim) misused \$100's of millions, many members, and much property. Finally, Hak Ja Han kicked out True Father's chosen inheritor and took control of all that was left. Worst of all, she is obliterating Father's words and deeds and proclaiming herself the Chosen One.
8. God's new providence was partially foretold by True Father when he proclaimed the future Peace Police and Peace Militia. The Kingdom of Heaven will most likely not now be able to come peacefully. Evil has such a strong foothold on money and power. It will not give up power without violently resisting. Evil must be exposed and in the end God and humanity must eliminate Evil from the world.
9. God and True Father chose Hyung Jin Nim as his heir and successor. He was crowned multiple times for this role and responsibility. With all his inheritance being stolen, he was forced to go into the wilderness. There he began his reign as the Second King, faithfully following his Father, the Second Coming of Christ and the First King of Kings.
10. With most all of True Father's foundation lost, God must start again to build another foundation for the Kingdom of Heaven on earth. Hyung Jin Nim was prepared by God with the warrior spirit which is needed for this new providence.

23 Jesus turned and said to Peter, “Get behind me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to me; you do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns.”

24 Then Jesus said to his disciples, “Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. 25 For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will find it. 26 What good will it be for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul? Or what can anyone give in exchange for their soul? 27 For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father’s glory with his angels, and then he will reward each person according to what they have done.

### **Mark 8:31 - 33 New International Version (NIV)**

31 He then began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests and the teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and after three days rise again. 32 He spoke plainly about this, and Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him.

33 But when Jesus turned and looked at his disciples, he rebuked Peter. “Get behind me, Satan!” he said. “You do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns.”

### **Luke 23: 27 - 30 New International Version (NIV)**

A large number of people followed him, including women who mourned and wailed for him.

28 Jesus turned and said to them, “Daughters of Jerusalem, do not weep for me; weep for yourselves and for your children. 29 For the time will come when you will say, ‘Blessed are the childless women, the wombs that never bore and the breasts that never nursed!’ 30 Then “they will say to the mountains, “Fall on us!” and to the hills, “Cover us!””[Hosea 10:8]
