A NOTE ABOUT COVID-19

YAYAM is dedicated to the health and safety of our summer camp staff and participants. While we are excited to offer in-person experiences for our youth, we are requiring the following protocols to help keep each other healthy.

2021 Summer Camp Requirements:

1. Vaccinated individuals are not required to wear a mask. For the protection of everyone, we encourage you to take advantage of the COVID-19 vaccination offered free of charge through your local Health Department, and various pharmacies in your area.
2. Some experiences may be modified to reduce physical contact.
4. Please be mindful of keeping your social distance around other participants.
5. If you have flu-like symptoms such as a cough or fever, we encourage you to stay home. Staff will send home any participants who present flu-like symptoms.

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death.

By participating in one of YAYAM's in-person summer camps, participants voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.
