Sun Myung Moon and Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon, who have sacrificed their lives to achieve a peaceful world, where humanity can live in happiness. In addition, the inauguration of the International Association of Academics for Peace Symposium will be held at the Peace Symposium.

This year's International Peace Symposium will be held for two days, where 500 scholars and academicians from around the world will be discussing on a path to achieving world peace, under the theme of "Achieving the World Centered on Interdependence, Mutual Prosperity, and Universal Values." Hosted by the Hyojeong Academy of Arts and Sciences, the Peace Symposium will be divided into five sub-groups of the International Conference on the Unity of the Sciences (ICUS), Professors World Peace Academy (PWPA), the Unity of the Societies of the Americas (CAUSA), and Sun Moon
