As we observe the recent eruption of conflict and violence in the Holy Land, our hearts are deeply saddened. The Universal Peace Federation, through its Middle East Peace Initiative, inaugurated in 2003, has worked continuously to promote dialogue and cooperation among stakeholders in the Holy Land, especially among religious leaders of the Abrahamic faiths. We therefore appeal to people throughout the world to join together and call for an end to the bloodshed. We trust that by coming together in sincere dialogue and a search for solutions, we can take immediate and necessary steps toward a better tomorrow.
