## **Backgrounder**

### **The United Nations Commission on the Status of Women**

The United Nations Commission on the Status of Women (UN CSW), is a functional commission of the UN Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC), and was established in 1946. The UN CSW is the principal global intergovernmental body dedicated to the promotion of gender equality and the empowerment of women, and promotes, reports on and monitors issues relating to the political, economic, civil, social, and educational rights of women. Since 2011, UN Women serves as the Secretariat for CSW.

The UN CSW meets in the UN Headquarters in New York for an annual two week session, which is attended by representatives of UN member states, civil society organizations and UN entities. Thousands of women travel to New York from around the world, to attend hundreds of events that are held in the UN, known as side events, as well as in venues throughout New York City, known as parallel events. NGO CSW NY facilitates the participation of civil society.

The 60th Session of UN CSW will run from Monday, March 14 - Thursday, March 24. The priority theme for CSW60 is "Women's Empowerment and its Link to Sustainable Development."

### **The Women's Federation for World Peace, International**

The Women's Federation for World Peace, International (WFWPI) is an NGO that seeks to empower women with the knowledge, skills, and support needed to realize genuine and sustainable peace.
