included many northern groups who inaugurated a landmark and then walked in caravan to Plaza de Mayo, where a representative dance and an indigenous camp were shared.



The planting was also done under the "Let's Plant Trees: Let's Sow Peace" campaign, promoted by the literary-ecological program "Y volverán a ser árboles" along with UPF-Argentina, a commitment to culture and peaceful coexistence among peoples and the natural environment.
