1. Key programs of the Blessing Ceremony

- Date: 1.3-7 by the heavenly calendar (**February 12-16, 2013**)
- Venue: Cheon Jeong Gung and Cheonga Camp, Korea
- Participants: Confirmed Cheon II Guk Matched Candidates
- Candidates should arrive and register at the venue by 11:00 am, February 12
- 2) Main Blessing Ceremony
- Date and Time: 11:00 am, 1.8 by the heavenly calendar (February 17, 2013)
- Venue: Cheonshim Peace World Center, Korea
- Participants: Confirmed Blessing Participants
- 3) Programs for single 1st and 2nd generation matched brides and grooms
- Date: 1.7-8 by the heavenly calendar (**February 16-17, 2013**)
- Venue: Yangpyeong, Hanhwa Resort and other accommodations
- Participants: All matched couples
- Matched couples should arrive and register at the venue by 11:00 am, February 16

- 2) Ceremonial items (provided by the Korean Headquarters) will be distributed at each accommodations
- Men will be given a corsage and a pair of white gloves
- Women will be given a wedding veil, bouquet, and a pair of white gloves

7. Registration fee for those participating in the Blessing Ceremony in Korea

- 1) The following fees will be charged for previously married couples, single 1st generation couples, matched 2nd generation couples from:
- Korea: To pay a designated amount
- Japan: To pay a designated amount
- USA, Canada, Western Europe, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Singapore, Australia, New Zealand: \$600
- Other nations: \$200
 (African nations and Oceania nations excluding Australia and New Zealand: \$100)
- 2) Guests and other participants
- \$300 will be charged per person during their stay in Korea (**from February 15-18**). Those staying beyond the official period are expected to pay additional charges
- * Regional headquarters should collect the registration fee for all their participants and submit this to the Korean Headquarters.
- * The registration fee should be paid out from the Blessing Donation (for 2nd generation, 1st generation candidates and previously married couples) collected by each region
- * Below is a breakdown of additional expenses for early arrivals or those who plan to extend their stay beyond the official period:
 - Meals are 8,000 won per meal per person
 - Accommodations will be 15,000 won per day per person
 - Transportation will be 20,000 won per person for those who require this service outside the official period.

- 2) Please guide all blessing candidates of the significance of the Blessing so that they can further enhance the dignity of this ceremony.
- 3) Please be sure to remind the candidates are solely accountable for the cancellation of their engagement or dissolution of the blessing caused by their non-principled actions. Please make sure you provide the necessary spiritual guidance before deciding to send anyone to Korea.
- 4) Previously married couples (including those with one partner in the Spiritual World) should take part in the Holy Wine Ceremony at their local churches before coming to the Blessing Ceremony in Korea.
- 5) After receiving the Blessing, all previously married couples should be guided so that they take part in the indemnity rod ceremony, and complete the 40-day separation period and three-day ceremony.
- 6) Parents and guests who will take part in the Blessing Ceremony in Korea should conform to the appropriate dress code (men: dark-colored suit, women: white or cream-colored suit or dress) and arrive and be seated at the Blessing venue by 10:00 am.
