## Chang Shik Yang speaks at CARP-Korea's Leadership Training

Dr. Chang Shik Yang spoke to CARP leaders at the CARP center during the three-day CARP Leadership Training workshop on May 10-12, 2013.

Since 1966 in Korea, the Collegiate Association for the Research of Principles (CARP) started its mission on college campuses to follow True Parents' words. CARP began an enlightenment movement for rural communities, an anti- communism movement with criticism lectures, seminars promoting the unification of North and South Korea and purity movement.

After the departure of the Cheon II Guk, CARP is preparing new leap to fulfill their mission. With True Parents words "Restore the Campus" as guidance, CARP-Korea has made local student councils (president, vice president and manager) for 40 main universities.

The presidents and vice presidents are called "*Heon Su Saeng*" who take a year off from school and stay at the CARP center 24 hours to support the local CARP leaders. Also central student presidential group has planning team, culture team and promotional team and provides information that local church needed.

CARP has a national student council, central student council and local student council. The leaders of the these councils came together and to attend a Leadership Training on May 10th to May 12th at *Eulwang-ri* 

beach in Incheon, Korea. This leadership training was to share the best practices of local CARP chapter activities and to discuss systematical witnessing methods.

The first day started with the orientation and praise at the CARP center. After the praise Dr. Chang Shik Yang gave a speech. Dr. Yang emphasized that the time at the college is very important and that people need to grow their perspectives on their life, choose a major and develop basic skills. Dr. Yang said "Also there is one more important thing which is feeling God's heart." He emphasized the importance of the witnessing and said that when someone witnesses, they can feel God's heart the most. He also shared an anecdote about Archbishop Emmanual Millingo and Archbishop George Augustus Stallings getting blessed by True Parents, which was hard for the world to understand why True Parents were trying to bless the priests. But he said, "I f you understand that this is God's providence then you will work harder than any other person. "He concluded by telling the CARP leaders that they need to have at least three spiritual children during their student life and asked for CARP leaders to remain determined.

The second day started with a morning *Hoon Dok Hae* and the participants shared their vision of CARP and local activities that take place in their local chapters. Afterwards, the participants went to Eulwang-ri beach where they partook in a teamwork game, entertainments and prayer. Later on, there was an evening session which was a team meeting. At the team meeting they discussed topics such as "What is the real hope?" and "Who are the people I want to share my love, heart and culture?" They then presented their thoughts with the whole group.

On the third day also began with *Hoon Dok Hae*. Then the central student council gave testimonies about

their experience attending a 40- day workshop during the summer vacation and reported their activities through a video. The central student council encouraged the local CARP leaders, the Leadership Training participants, to go to the 40- day workshops. Afterwards, the participants discussed "how to register as a club at the universities" and "how to organize Campus Church Leaders (CCL)."

The closing ceremony was presided by Mr. Kyeong Deuk Ryu, vice-president of Family Federation for World Peace and Unification, and Mr. In Seon Shin, president of CARP-Korea. They presented the written appointment to the CARP leaders.

Mr. In Seon Shin said, "To become leaders that bring the victory of the Vision 2020, we need to be a true owner. The owner of school is not the president of the university or professors but students. The purpose of the school is for the students. CARP is same. The students will be the owner of the CARP. So that is why we need to make local student council and vitalize the activities in school and through this we will work on witnessing. Everything should be centered on students. I'll tour the 40 universities and share these activities."

Mr. Kyeong Deuk Ryu said, "Hyo Jin Nim told me that if you want to be a respected leader, first you need to be responsible person. And you need to have leadership, a strong drive and good judgment. Additionally you need be a leader that has vision for the future." He also emphasized in order to become a leader of the Unification Church they should know the tradition of the church and they need to be a person who inherits Heaven's tradition centered on the providence. He added, "The way to inherit Heaven's tradition is first the need for us to inherit the blood lineage then inherit the teachings and the last is to then practice the teachings. Then there will be real hope in you."
