Scholarship Program

May the blessings and love of the Heavenly Parent and True Parents be with all regions and mission nations.

Under the special instructions of True Parents, the Wonmo Pyeongae Foundation created the Sun Moon University Scholarship Support Program for International Students and is now receiving applications for the 2013 Winter Semester. We would like to ask all regional headquarters to base their selection of scholarship recipients on the guidelines within the attached program guidebook.

A. Number of Students to be Accepted to the 2013 Winter Semester: 86 applicants

- If the number of recommended students by region surpasses 86, the Wonmo Pyeongae Foundation can adjust the number of applicants through consultation with the regional headquarters.

B. Applicants

- High school graduates or students expecting to graduate from high school in 2014 from all concerned countries except for Japan (Japan is scheduled to select students in January 2014 for the 2014 spring semester.)
- Students that can complete the entire Korean language course (one year) and an undergraduate course (four years)
- Students that can dedicate themselves to a public course in the church for two years after completing their scholarship program
 - Each regional headquarters has received and should retain the written oath through which applicants pledge to dedicate themselves to a public church course for two years

C. Selection Procedure:

Each regional headquarters must screen documents submitted by applicants and select candidates based on the guidelines within the attached guidebook.
