Under the special instruction of True Parents, the Wonmo Pyeongae Foundation is now receiving applications for the **Wonmo Pyeongae Global Leaders Scholarship Program** for competent leaders in the public mission who have potential to serve as the national leader for that mission nation. We would like to ask all regional headquarters to base their selection of scholarship recipients on the guidelines within the attached program guidebook.

- 1. Number of scholarship students to be accepted for the March 2014 semester for the Korean Language Course at the Sunmoon University: 30 applicants
- 2. Applicants must satisfy all four qualifications below:
 - 1) A person serving in a public mission upon the recommendation by the regional president or national leader in the mission nation and who has potential to serve as its national leader
 - 2) High school graduates or those with an equivalent education or higher
 - 3) A person who can complete the entire Korean Language course (one year)
 - 4) A person who commits to return to their nation and serve the public mission under the direction of the regional president after completing their scholarship program

3. Selection Procedure:

Each Regional headquarters must screen documents submitted by applicants and select candidates based on the guidelines within the attached guidebook.

4. How to Submit Documents

- 1) Deadline of submission: January 24, 2014
- 2) Required Documents: All personal documents attached within the guidebook and a recommendation letter by the regional president.
 - * All documents should be submitted to the Sunmoon University by post. They must be the original documents. In case submission of documents is overdue for some



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unavoidable reason, one can send a copy of the original document by fax or e-mail first and then you may send the original document later.

Information of '2014 Wonmo Pyeongae Global Leaders Scholarship Program for Korean Language

1. Program Objective

The objective of the Wonmo Pyeongae Global Leaders Scholarship Program is to provide international students with the opportunity to learn Korean at Sun Moon University in order to support founder's intent to strengthen-education, building global network and activating exchange.

2. Academic Programs

A one-year Korean Language Education in Sun Moon University, Korea.

3. Qualifications of applicants for scholarship program

Prospective applicants must meet the following qualification criteria:

- (1) Must be a citizen of the country to which scholarships are offered. (Applicants must not be a holder of Korean citizenship)
- (2) Have an adequate health, both physically and mentally.
 - * Persons who are pregnant or having severe illness may not apply.
- (3) Have finished or be scheduled to finish formal education of high school.
- (4) Recommended by National Leader or Regional President of church.

4. Tuition and Scholarship Benefit per year

(1) Korean Language course: The whole tuition of Korean Language course will be provided by the Foundation. (Students are expected to be responsible to pay for room, meals and personal expenses)

- (2) Notes: Students will receive the scholarship when they fulfill following conditions.
 - ① The length of Korean Language course is 1 year and can be extended half a year more if necessary.
 - ② During the Korean Language course, Students have to attend in every class (The ratio of attendance has to exceed 90% of class time) including summer and winter session. If a student has any special reason to absent in a class, he/she has to get the permission of teacher before.
 - 3 Students have to attend in Sunday service which is offered by the church of Sun Moon University. (The ratio of attendance has to exceed 90%)
 - ④ Students have to attend in education program which is offered by the Wonmo Pyeongae Foundation.

9. Other Important things

- (1) Entry
 - ① Grantees must arrive in Korea until Feb 25, 2014. In case a grantee does not enter Korea by the date stated above without any special reason, his/her scholarship award will be cancelled.
 - ② Prior to arrival, grantees should acquire some knowledge about the Korean climate, customs, culture, etc.

- ③ Grantees are required to get a visa (D-4) before arriving in Korea.
- * Visit the Consular section of the Korean embassy or consulate in your country of residence with the invitation letter from Sun Moon University, after being informed of selection as a grantee.
 - ④ Every grantee should read this information thoroughly before coming to Korea and keep it for reference while staying in Korea, which will be distributed prior to arriving in Korea.
 - ⑤ Every grantee is advised to prepare enough money to cover the boarding expenses and the personal expenses for the studying period. Extra work or part time job does not allowed during the Korean Language courses.
- (2) Housing
 - ① Grantees would reside in a university dormitory.
 - ② Each room will be shared by 4 students.
- (3) Korean Language Course
 - ① Duration: First Semester 2014: March 3, 2014 ~ June 18,2014
 - 2 Institution: Korean Language Institute at Sun Moon University
- (4) Cancellation or suspension of Scholarship
 - ① If a grantee is found engaged in any of the following activities during his/her stay in Korea, his/her scholarship will be suspended and then will be disqualified from a grantee position.
 - When any documents of the scholarship application has been found false.
 - When the grantee is punished by the university or involved in any form of political activity.
 - When the grantee has violated the written pledge which s/he has given to Sun Moon University.
 - When the grantee has violated the guidelines and regulations set by Sun Moon University.
 - When the grantee has been cautioned more than 2 times due to an unexcused absence or a prolonged absence from the Korean language training or the temporary departure without permission or notification
 - When the grantee has given up one's studies.

- (1) I understand that there is a scholarship for tuition. But are there other, out of pocket fees or expenses that I should know about?
- ⇒ Please refer to the table (#5) for the description of scholarship. The other expenses you need to pay are followed.
- O Room and Board: \$3,200 per year (including 10 meals per week):
- O Insurance Fee: about \$100 (100,000 won) a year:

Every international student at Sun Moon University should join insurance service provided by Sun Moon University unless you already join another international insurance service by yourself.

- (2) What happens to the international students when school is not in session? Where do they sleep? Eat?
- ⇒ Those who want to stay in the campus during vacations can stay at dormitory as long as they apply in advance (during session). The dormitory cafeteria is also opened during vacation. After you pay the dorm fee, you can use dormitory cafeteria after purchasing meal tickets.
- (3) What is the situation with medical coverage and medical insurance? Can I use the school's health center? What happens if I have a major incident while I am away?
- ⇒ There is a health center on the first floor of Student Building in Campus. The incident happens in Korea can be covered by the insurance. Please refer to the table below for description of medical coverage.
