Chung Shik Yang on Father's First Wife Sun Kil Choi

In 2009 Dr. Chung Shik Yang delivered an incredible 2 day seminar on True Father's life in Sydney. He said in summary, that God's plan was that True Father was to meet Jesus and inherit his mission in 1935. The next ten years was preparation to begin his mission and to discover the truth Divine Principle. In 1945 he married his first wife Sun Kil Choi, then the building of Chung Il Guk would have started and be established in seven years by 1953.

At this time Father was 33 years old and rather than being crucified, he would have received a special crowning ceremony from heaven and Christianity. But he could not accomplish this without a wife completely united and supporting him. Sun Kil Choi was from the Christian community that never bowed to the Japanese shrines during the Japanese occupation, and so many were martyred because of this. These were the Abel type Christians. So Sun Kil Choi was in a John the Baptist position.

Unfortunately, she could not keep her position, and lost faith in Father as the Messiah. Because of her failure Father lost his family foundation, and this meant he lost the national and cosmic foundations as well.

As the Third Adam he should not have had to go through a suffering course, but he had to start again from the lowest level as servant of servants level, on a wilderness course from 1945 to 1985. This entailed going to North Korea, imprisonments, Hungnam concentration camp, and starting from Busan from a church made from wooden boxes.

Seven years from 1985 Father proclaimed the Completed Testament age in 1993, then seven years later he launched the establishment of Chung Il Guk. He said that 2013 would be the end of the completion stage of this presumably this would be the Foundation Day Blessing.

Hak Ja Han by saying that Father should not have married his first wife Sun Kil Choi shows that she does not understand Father's course and is very disrespectful to the suffering course that Father went through that enabled God's providence to progress. It is an insult to Father and to Sun Kil Choi and her son Sung Jin Nim, as although she failed her mission, but I understand she repented and came back to the church. Hak Ja Han's comments reveals that she may consider all of this as meaningless to her.

It's a long time since we heard seminars like this on Father's life, it seems that it is not in the Family Federation's interests.. I asked some of the second generation what they understood about Father's first wife, and nearly all of those I asked said that they never heard that Father even had a first wife.

Hak Ja Han is step by step trying to erase the history of Father's course by deleting sections of Father's words, also by omitting to educate members especially the youth about Father's course.
