

SunHak History Institute -- True Parents Academy First Term

As the academy wraps up week 4, half of the schedule has passed. For four weeks, the trainees had a meaningful time to have a clear providential perspective and to realize True Parents' feelings through lifelong education for True Parents and practical work at the Seonhak History Compilation Center.

As the main training schedule for the 4th week, the 12th (Mon) 'Provide Writing' training by team leader Sang-eun Park of the Compilation Bureau and the 13th (Tue), 15th (Thu), and 16th (Fri) 'Introduction to the reverse content' by Kang Hyeon-deok, team leader of the General Operations Bureau and future content direction' and 'understanding planning work' were provided.



And on the 14th (Wednesday), researcher Hyo Jin Choi, who is currently working at the Institute of Information and Archiving at Hankuk University of Foreign Studies, was invited to 'Archive! Who are you?' The third special lecture was held. We had a useful time to understand the basic concepts of archives, such as the various meanings of archives, the birth of community archives, and the specificity of archives, and to find out what direction to archive Providence materials through the current archive

system at the Seonhak Historic Archives. I did.

So far, if the trainees have focused on True Parents lifelong education and practical education, the next four weeks will be a project to directly plan and produce educational content. I think that trainees will grow even more through the process of developing the knowledge they have learned and felt through the background knowledge of Providence and practical work as a result. Compilation Guk Director Park Sang-eun's comments on 'Provide Writing' education

"It was good to understand if there was a providential background to an important providential event or event, and when I read True Parents' speeches, I could understand that 'this is why he said these things'. In the afternoon, the work continued at the video office. It was the work of linking the video to the annals, but after watching the video of True Parents' world tour lecture, I was able to understand the background and thought I should also find and read the lecture."

"I was impressed with the saying, "even the events that gave a lot of manpower and time are recorded in one line in the annals." Hearing those words in the morning training class, I was able to feel a lot while actually registering the annals. There is a limit to conveying all the facts. It was a pity that it was recorded in about one line in the annals, but for that reason, I have to pay more attention to each line recorded in the annals and write it so that the meaning can be conveyed well. I realized that it is not an easy task."

"Through today's lecture, I was able to understand the meaning of the Day of Hope conference held in the United States. The role of the United States was important because communism was prevalent in the 1970s, and wars and conflicts were taking place in various regions. Knowing that it should be, I felt that America was and will be important to Providence."

'Content Future Prospects and Search' and 'Understanding Planning Tasks' training impressions on 'Content Future Prospects and Search'

I was reading a book by Kang Won-guk, and he said that a leader who does everything he does is not a good leader, saying that he is frustrated over certain things. During the lecture by Team Leader Kang, I also remembered that planning should be done together, not alone. It was a grateful day."
