# **UTS Korean Speech Contest**

UTS is opening the door to every region and state, and encouraging all non-native Korean UC members to participate beginning this year. For the convenience of those who are at a distance, UTS is willing to accept videotape submissions for both preliminary and final.

## The Contest Standards

- A. Qualification of the Contestants
  - 18 year or older non-native Korean
- B. Levels of the Contestants and their Contents
  - 1. Elementary and Advanced levels

The Elementary level is for those whose knowledge is not good enough to compose his or her speech. They will recite a 3-4 minute-long section of True Parents' Words or Prayer.

The Advanced level participants must compose their own 4-5 minute-long speech on any topic.

- 2. In the finals, the finalists will develop the material that they used for the preliminary. For final, elementary is given 4-5 minutes and advanced 5-7 minutes.
- C. Requirement
  - 1. Elementary level: Must know the context through English-translated version.
  - 2. Advanced level:

For the preliminary, correction of writing and memorization is <u>not required</u>. For the final, correction of writing is <u>required</u> by Korean speaking natives. Memorization is not required but <u>preferred</u>. Paper may be used for a glance purpose only.

- D. Time Counting Policy
  - In order to allow the participants' time to fully express their hearts, there is no time counting in this contest. Nevertheless, they are asked to limit their time.

- E. Standardization of Judgment
  - 1. Preliminary

- 1. Diction : Pronunciation (50%), Intonation (30%)
- 2. Presence : Pausing & Pacing (10%)
- 3. Spirit : Conviction (5%), Enthusiasm (5%)

## ADVANCED

Contents : Clarity (10%), Arrangement (10%)
Diction : Pronunciation (30%), Intonation (20%)
Presence : Pausing and pacing (10%)
Spirit : Conviction (10%), Enthusiasm (10%)

# 2. Final

## ELEMENTARY

- 1. Diction : Pronunciation (20%), Intonation (10%)
- 2. Presence : Pausing & Pacing (10%), Eye contact & Facial Expression (10%)
- 3. Spirit : Conviction (25%), Enthusiasm (25%)

## <u>ADVANCED</u>

- 1. Contents : Clarity (10%), Arrangement (10%)
- 2. Diction : Pronunciation (10%), Intonation (10%)
- 3. Presence : Eye contact & Facial Expression (10%), Pausing and pacing (10%)
- 4. Spirit : Conviction (20%), Enthusiasm (20%)
- 3. Expectation on each category:
  - Pronunciation: Clear and comprehendible sound on <u>each words</u>.
  - Intonation: Accents and/or emphasis on important words and suitable stops in <u>each sentence</u> for accurate comprehension on its context.
  - Pausing and Pacing: Appropriate pause and pace for comprehending <u>entire context</u>.
  - Eye contact, Facial Expression, Conviction, and Enthusiasm: Very important part to move the heart of audience.
- 4. Expectation on each event for both levels:
  - <u>Preliminary</u>: Clear pronunciation and intonation is a must.
  - <u>Final</u>: Strong conviction and enthusiasm is expected

#### F. Submission and Deadline

- Preliminary: Submit the videotape of their reciting/speech together with the copy of their reciting material/composition by <u>April 29, 2006</u>.
- Final: It will be noticed. The main event is expected to be held in the middle of May.
