In 2013, Korea, Japan and the United States began dispatching Cheon Il Guk Youth Missionaries to strategic and providential nations in order to uphold True Mother's desire to train and educate dedicated youth from among our second generation membership.

Japan is presently conducting its 7th 40th-day workshop for Cheon Il Guk Youth Missionaries and plans to dispatch its 7th class of Cheon Il Guk youth missionaries to the world this coming June.

Accordingly, the International HQ would like to request each region's and all concerned leaders' understanding, active cooperation and guidance in relation to the dispatch of youth missionaries.

1. Purpose of Cheon Il Guk Youth Missionaries

- A. Train and educate dedicated, capable second-generation members
- B. Support the global mission (help accomplish Vision 2020)

2. Criteria when Selecting Mission nations for Cheon Il Guk Youth Missionaries

- A. The nation must be safe (good public safety record).
- B. The safety of the Cheon Il Guk youth missionaries should be ensured.
- C. The candidate nation should have a developed witnessing and education system.
- D. The priority for the missionaries should be witnessing and education; other activities should be kept to a minimum.
- E. The candidate nation should have a modern mobile communication networks (internet and mobile communications).
