Austrian Children's Workshop in Gaflenz, Austria - We are heroes of God

We want to share about this year's Austrian Children's Workshop, which took place from July 8th-12th, 2023, in our beautiful workshop place in Gaflenz, Upper Austria. Twenty-three Blessed Children between the ages of 5 and 14 participated in this workshop. The music group, headed by Nathalie Waldmann, even composed an original song entitled "We are heroes of God" on two afternoons.
