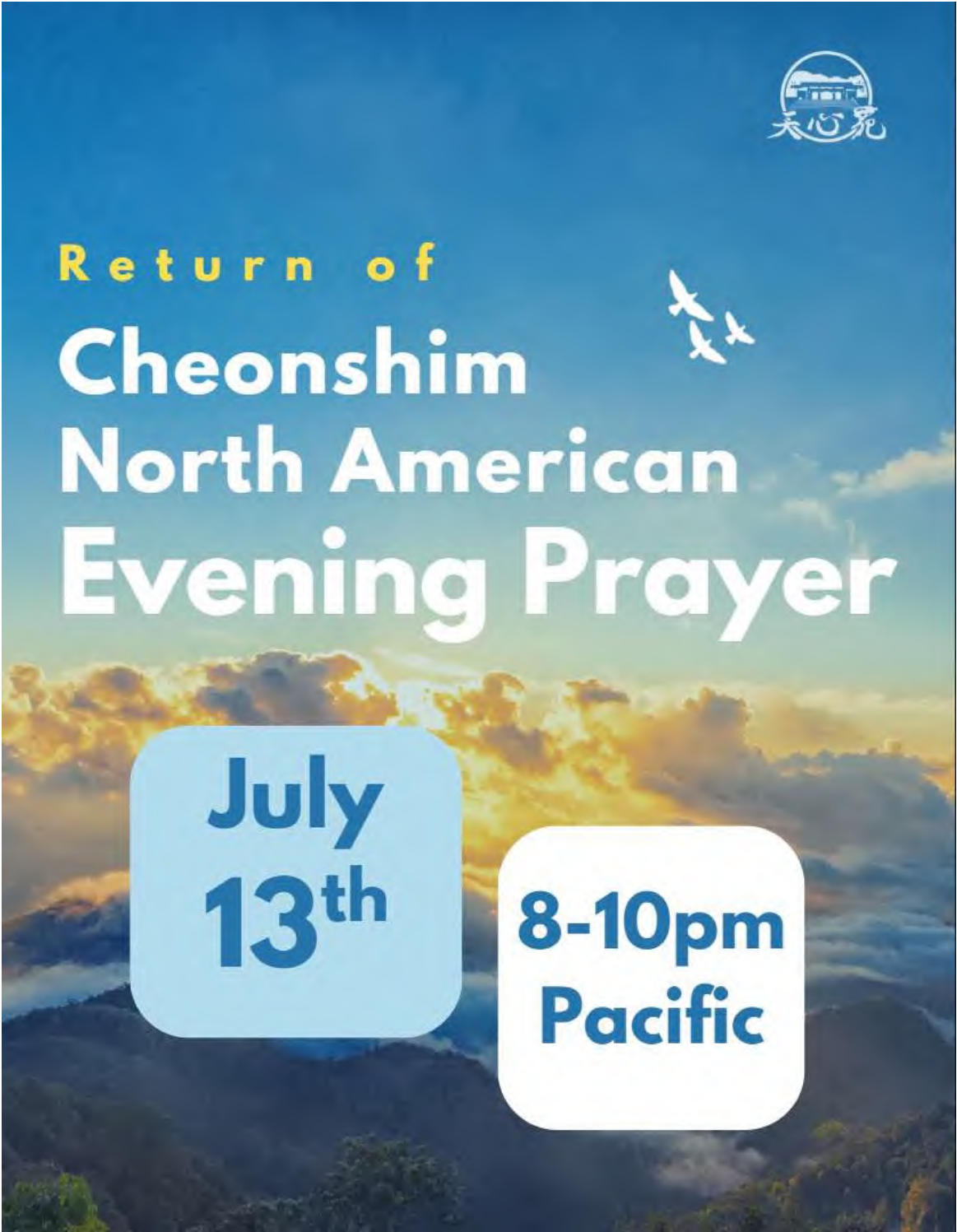

First of all, I'd like to thank HP & TPs for giving me this opportunity & allowing me to share the grace that I received during the third Family 7day Workshop at CSW USA.

Good evening everyone!

My name is Miyuki Matsuzaki from the Las Vegas Family Church. It has been five years since I came to the United States from Japan to have a family. I'm very blessed to be surrounded by my amazing husband and our three beautiful daughters.

Before the workshop, I wondered whether I should attend or not because I had already attended twice before, and this year I was pregnant while caring for my three young children. However, I wanted to offer the best spiritual environment to my children—including the baby in my womb—so I decided to attend once again.

Eventually, thanks to the wonderful babysitters, I was able to focus on the program more than ever before. As a result, I received tremendous grace and inspiration from each lecture and every part of the program. Among the many blessings I received, today I would like to share the two that touched my heart the most.

The first blessing I would like to share is that, through the Song Practice session, I was able to experience TM's heart in a much deeper and more personal way. We practiced three songs, but the one that touched me the most was “나 홀로.” I had heard and sung this song many times before. However, this time we were given the opportunity to slowly reflect on the meaning of the lyrics, and that made a big difference for me.

As I pictured the scene described in the song, I could deeply feel the heart of a mother searching for her child in the middle of a raging sandstorm. Just standing in such a storm would be incredibly difficult. But if your child were crying out for help somewhere in the storm, any parent would desperately call their child's name and search with everything they had, even risking their own life.

By placing myself in that situation, I realized that these lyrics truly express the desperate and unconditional heart of a mother. I came to feel that TM has continued walking her course without thinking of her own physical well-being because she truly looks upon all humanity with a mother's heart. And I realized that this is the very heart of our HP.

Through this song, I could deeply feel that our HP and TM never stop searching for every one of their children and we are the very fruits of their blood, sweat and tears. It also gave me a renewed sense of responsibility to help people hear their loving call.

The second blessing I would like to share is that, through Dr. Kambashi's lecture on 참부모론 and Rev. Kishimoto's session on practicing Resonance Prayer, I was able to rediscover the value of both myself and my brothers and sisters.

This was the fourth time I had listened to Dr. Kambashi's lecture on 참부모론, but every time the content is updated, bringing fresh learning and deep inspiration. This time, we were given the opportunity to read parts of the lecture aloud together and share what we had personally felt. That process helped me internalize the message much more deeply.

One point that especially touched me was TM's teaching that "becoming absolutely one with God" means making the invisible Creator visible through my life. Through this explanation, I began to realize that every single moment of my daily life is filled with opportunities to reveal the invisible HP and experience HP working through my life. Even the ordinary moments of life became precious and deeply meaningful to me. What amazed me even more was realizing that this is the very purpose of our life on earth. It was truly a life-changing realization for me.

After the lecture, as I was walking while holding my child's little hand, a thought suddenly came to my heart. I realized, "Perhaps HP wanted to experience the warmth and preciousness of this little hand through me." At that moment, I was deeply moved. It made me wonder how many moments of awe and beauty are hidden within my ordinary daily life, and how beautiful my life could become if HP can truly dwell within me.

Another important realization was that the true value of Jesus and the TP is not found merely in outward results, but in how they revealed HP through every circumstance. Even when they faced rejection, imprisonment, or misunderstanding, they never stopped embodying HP's unchanging love. I realized that this is where their true value lies. This gave me a much clearer vision of how I want to live my own life and how I can share the value of the True Parents with others.

During Rev. Kishimoto's session on Resonance Prayer, I was able to feel HP's presence within the heart of each person.

Because our group was relatively small this time, everyone had the opportunity to come to the front and offer a representative prayer. Listening to each person's prayer, I couldn't hold back my tears. I felt that every brother and sister reveals a unique aspect of HP's heart. It reminded me how precious our spiritual family is and inspired me to treat every person with greater gratitude and respect.

I also felt that the same attitude should extend to those who have not yet come to know HP and TPs. When I meet someone with the heart of asking, "What aspect of God's love and divine nature is this person here to reveal?" I believe there are endless opportunities for learning, inspiration, and growth.
