

Belarus Members Take Part in ‘Uzor’ Festival

FFWPU members in Belarus were active in the big family festival “Uzor.” More than 2,000 people visited the festival, which took place in Minsk, the capital, on Saturday, May 18.

The festival was organized by the local administration of Minsk city, the republic center of national cultures, the Family Home educational center, and the Family World public association.

The word uzor in Belarusian means “tracery,” but it also means “sample.” The festival aims to spread true family values, create an attractive family lifestyle, and promote a healthy lifestyle. A big concert took place on the main stage from 11:00 in the morning until 19:00 in the evening. Performances were offered by different national groups permanently living in Belarus and by groups of children.

Art master classes, sports competitions, lectures about family life, an artisan fair, food court, a soap bubble show and many other interesting things were provided for the visitors. National farmsteads of Moldova, Russia, and Tatar-Bashkirs were presented at the festival.

Certificates and prizes were awarded to large families; the family celebrating a golden wedding anniversary; the family of a man who was injured by a mine in his youth but did not give up, started a family and became a motivational speaker and inspiration for other people.
