After the service activity, volunteers shared refreshments and fellowship, with some staying on to enjoy volleyball or a peaceful walk around the lakes.



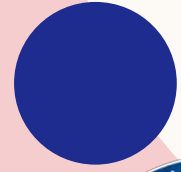
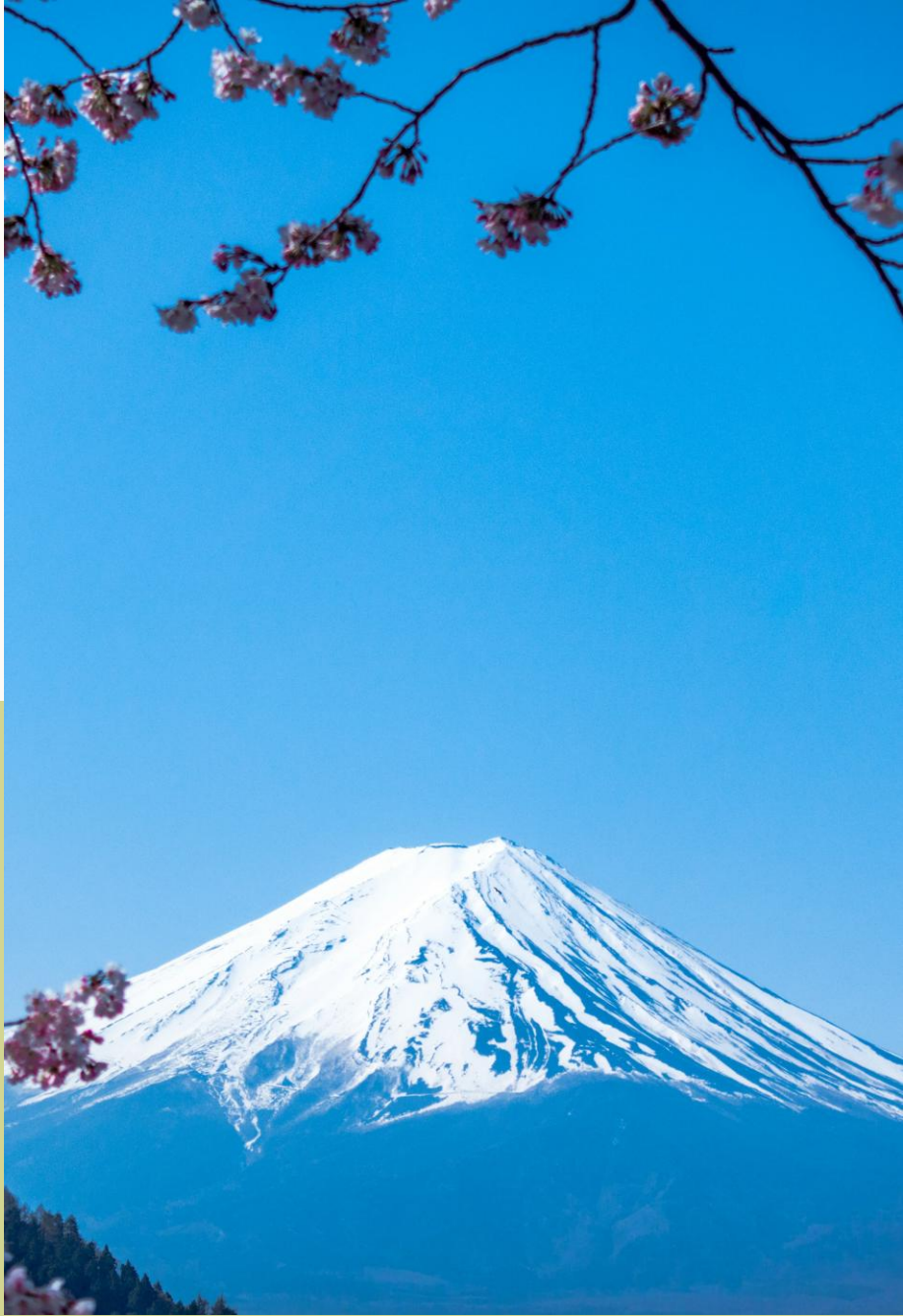
NATIONAL LEADER VISITS

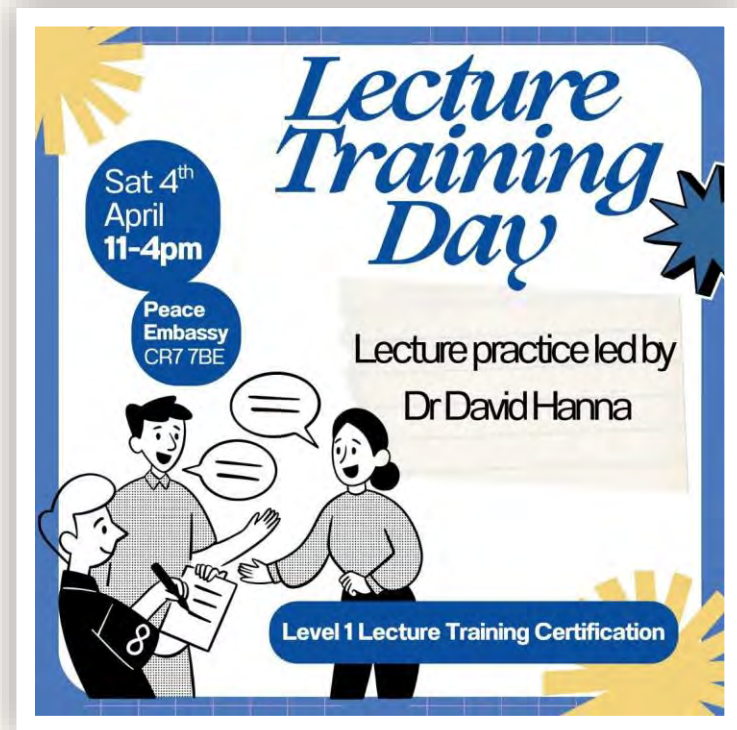


UPCOMING EVENTS
