SPECIAL GREAT WORKS: The Spring Special Great Works take place from May 1-3. Attending the Great Works, our quarterly time of prayer, dedication and recommitment, is strongly encouraged by True Parents, and is one of the main “duties of faith” of all Unificationist families.

We hope this Great Works will be a time for a special condition of filial devotion in support of our True Mother, who has now been confined for over 200 days. Just two months ago, at the Winter Great Works, we had our largest-ever EUME registration, with over 5,000 individuals. This time, we as EUME regions are challenging ourselves to reach 10,000 EUME participants!

We felt that an open discussion on the topic would help us to get a deeper understanding of the situation, reduce stigma and help us with practical knowledge when someone may be struggling, and how to offer meaningful support.

We are delighted to have our sister Margoth Tove Kalstad as our main speaker. Margoth is a licensed Gestalt psychotherapist, a trained bereavement facilitator and suicide prevention volunteer. She volunteers at the SOS- suicide prevention service/hotline with senior level responsibility.

During the webinar, we'll explore key risk factors, common warning signs, and supportive approaches that can help create safer, more connected communities.

There will be plenty of time for Q&A afterward.

The webinar will be online on Saturday May 30th at 7pm UK time.

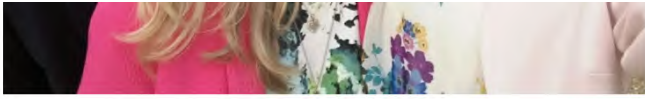

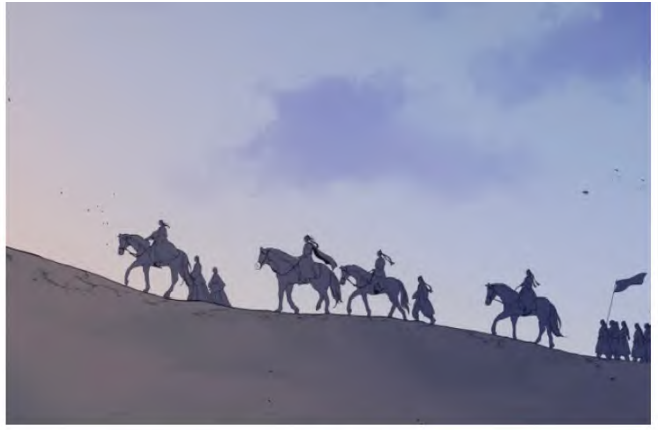

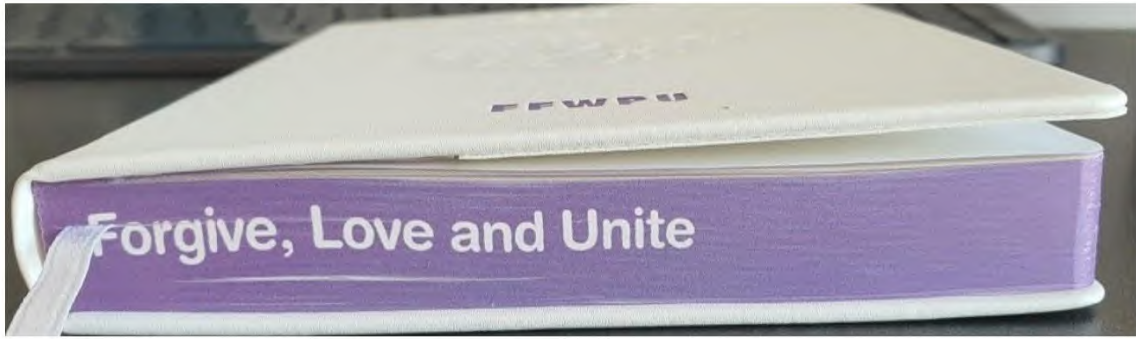
