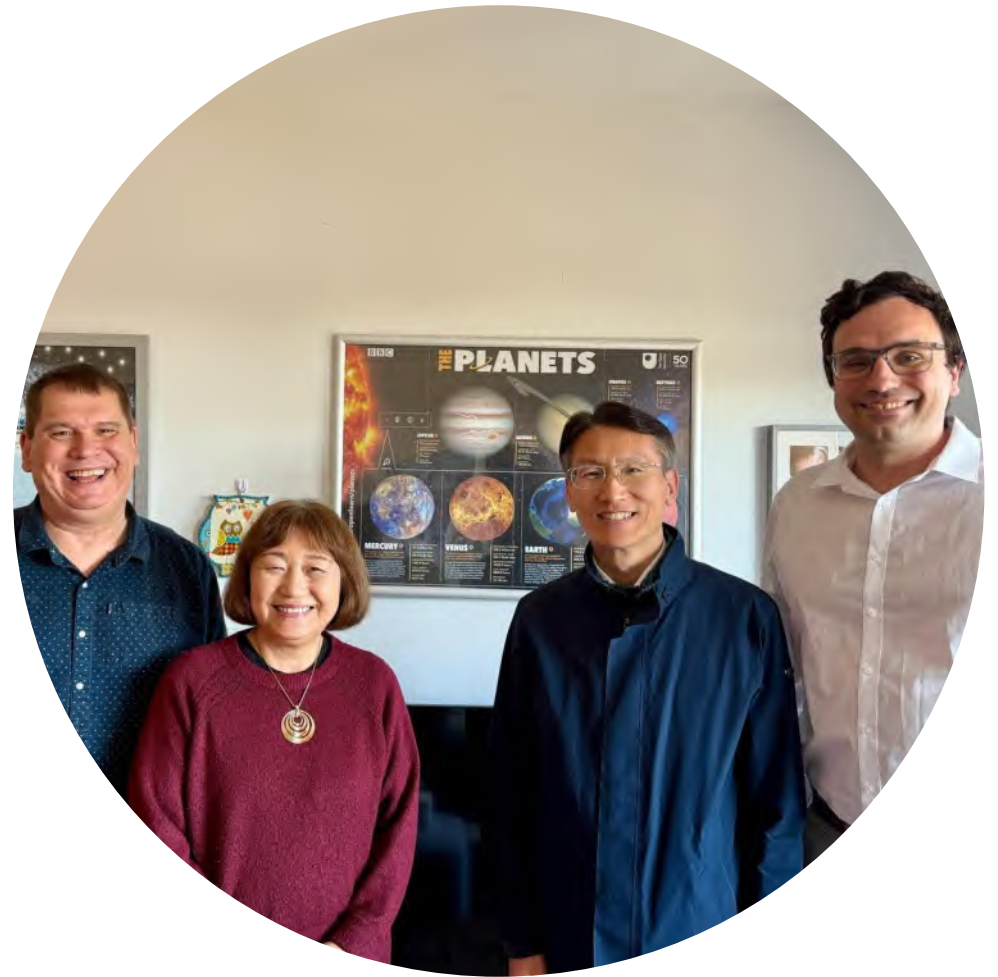
VISIT BY EUME CHEONBO BRANCH
