

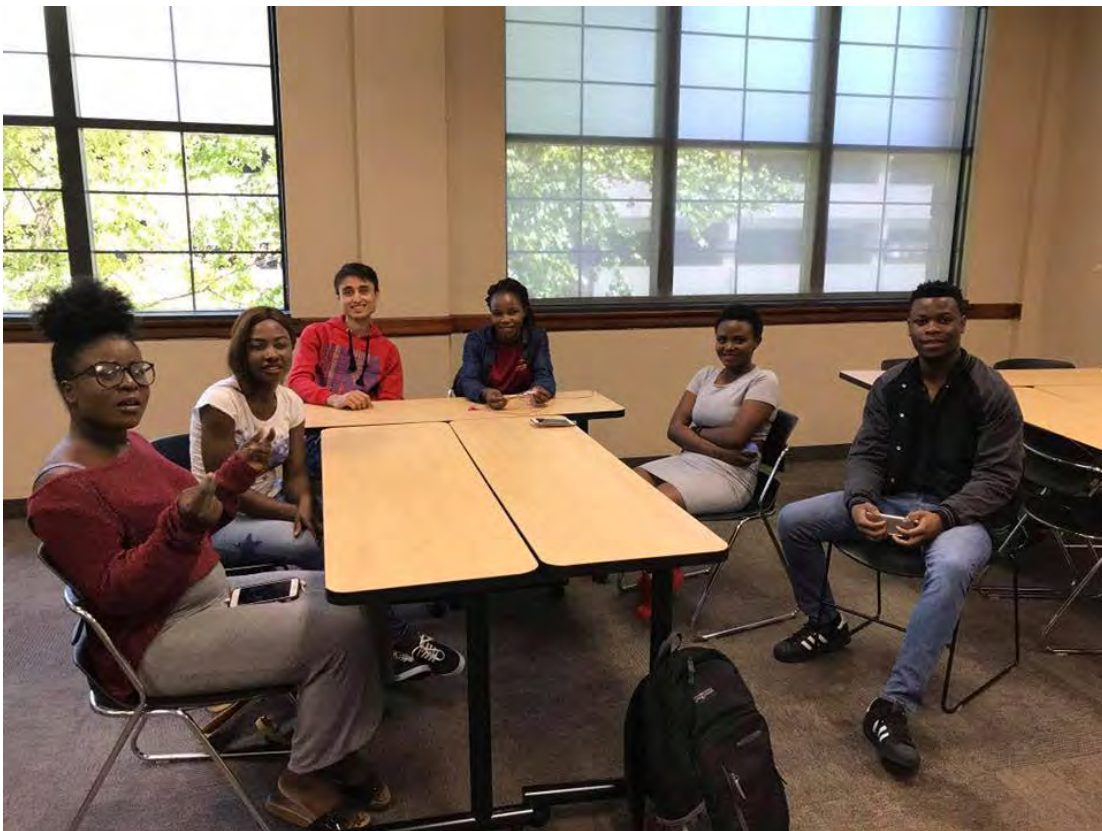


Dear ,
