## Marriage Blessing as part of the "Marriage Week"

Already at our last Vision 2020 meeting in September, we had formulated the plan to hold a Blessing in Stuttgart on Foundation Day, February 17, 2019. We had never before arranged a date so far in advance.

Help us to love each other, and forgive us our sins.

We thank you,

we praise you for the joy and happiness that you bring us.

We love you, we honor you, we praise your name when we sing.

Following these profound words and the loving performance, we raised our glasses and offered a toast. Each person looked into his/her partner's eyes or thought about him/her in their absence.

"Here's to marriage! - to the family! - to eternal true love!"
