E-Learning In A Pandemic


UTS Students Sound Off

Strictly online classes and now virtual graduations have become a big adjustment for millions of students, including those at the <u>Unification Theological Seminary</u> (UTS) in Barrytown, New York, which held its virtual commencement on Saturday, May 23.
