

May the blessings and love of Heavenly Parent and True Parents always accompany you.

In accordance with True Parents' instructions, the era of praying in the name of our "blessed central family" began in 1999. From 2001, prayers were transformed into "reports" to God, and from 2006 we started concluding our prayers with "Aju."

Since then, many more people are praying in their own names as individuals, in the name of a husband and wife, or in their family's name, yet no further guidelines were given over the years. Now, however, True Mother has made a clear request to us that we end our prayers in our individual name only.

Accordingly, this memo is to clarify our prayer ending. We ask that leaders, blessed families, and members at the regional headquarters familiarize themselves with this information and provide guidance so that prayers can be concluded according to the following guidelines:

1. Blessed Family Member's Prayer Closing

A. "I pray (or report) in the name of [name of the one praying] of a blessed central family. Aju"

2. Related Matters

- A. Blessed children who have not yet received the Blessing are asked to pray "in the name of [name of the one praying], a 2nd (3rd, 4th) generation blessed child. Aju." For single 1st generation members, please pray in the name of True Parents.
