Here are some additional clarifications about the event this weekend.

Food/ Drinks

<u>On Saturday, Oct. 5</u>, there will be some food for purchase <u>from 10:30am to 12:30pm</u>. Since the program <u>starts at 1pm</u>, we want to make sure everyone is ready by then.

Water will be available as well.

<u>On Sunday, Oct. 6</u>, we will have kimbap and water provided to each participant. When you arrive on Saturday at 'Check In', each person will receive a meal ticket for the <u>Sunday lunch</u>, please don't lose them.

On both days there will also be drinks (hot and cold) and snacks available for purchase throughout the day during the breaks.

Young Children
