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"In God's reign 'everything belongs,' even the broken and poor parts; the imperial systems of culture, however, demand 'in' people and 'out' people, victors and victims. Until we have utterly faced this battle in our own soul, we will usually perpetuate it in the outer world of politics and class. Dualistic thinking begins in the soul and moves to the mind and eventually moves to the streets. True prayer nips the lie in the bud. It is usually experienced as tears, surrender, or forgiveness." - Richard Rohr, Everything Belongs

If God is THE only source, then everything belongs - even imperfection, "Satan" and "evil" which means that, that which we consider "satanic", "Luciferian" or "Promethean" etc. is not a separate force but rather symptoms of spiritual/psychological illness occurring in originally healthy and good people.

The dualistic view, that there are "God's people" and "Satan's people", "blessed" and "fallen", saints and sinners, members and "the outside world", is a projection of, as Rohr implies, the imperial system of culture that demands in-people and out-people. It's an "us versus them" attitude. This mindset fosters separation and conflict - not unity and reconciliation.

Evil cannot be destroyed, conquered, relinquished, fought against or demolished. Evil must be understood, healed and restored back to its original state of health.
