We would like to inform you that there have been a couple positive COVID-19 cases diagnosed within some of our community members within the past week. We are working with the individuals involved to contact trace and encourage further testing to help ensure our community members remain safe and healthy.

While we do not know for certain, it is possible there could have been some level of COVID-19 exposure at our in-person services last Sunday August 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Out of an abundance of caution and concern, our Sub-Regional, Capital HPHC, and Council leadership teams have decided to suspend in-person services this Sunday August 29th **including the scheduled “BAND DAY”**.

We will assess the situation this week with the expectation that in-person services will resume the following Sunday September 5<sup>th</sup>. We further want to encourage any individuals that attended Sunday Service last Sunday, who may be experiencing symptoms or are concerned about the potential exposure, to please get tested.
