
HPHC DMV: This Weekend Events in the Capital HPHC

HJIFUS Job Openings – Executive Assistant, Research Director, Editor, Business/Marketing Director (October 19, 2021)

The Hyo Jeong International Foundation for the Unity of the Sciences (HJIFUS) is searching for dedicated people who wish to greatly contribute to finding, promoting, and implementing solutions to environmental challenges.

Four types of roles are available in either a full-time or part-time capacity. They are Executive Assistant, Research Director, Editor, and Marketing or Business Director.

Even though individual responsibilities may be specific, the nature of the work often involves collaboration with others. As a member of this team, expected competencies are (1) to have good oral and written communication skills, (2) organizational skills, (3) be able to provide timely reports, (4) to be humble and learn from mistakes, (5) be able to share the attitude and do work aligned with the direction of management, and (6) be able to understand HJIFUS's three unique solutions/approaches to the environment which are:

- 1. providing character education to improve people's attitude toward nature to combat selfishness, greed, and ignorance of the natural world,
- 2. implementing well-rounded scientific solutions derived from both conventional science and new paradigm science, and
- 3. collaborating in alignment with the principles of interdependence, mutual prosperity, and universally shared values.

Below are the specific responsibilities of each role

Executive Assistant

Responsibilities: On behalf of the President, (1) Write emails, letters, and directions to employees, HJIFUS partners, and professionals and (2) Collect reports from employees, process them, and organize them to be easily reviewed by the President.

Research Director (Similar titles offered are Associate Research Director or Assistant Research Director.)

Responsibilities: (1) Lead in environmental research, (2) Plan international environmental conferences, and (3) Cultivate various story threads on the environment for use by *The Earth & I* editorial team.
 Expected competencies: Extensive knowledge on environmental matters.

Editor (Similar titles offered are Associate Editor, Research Editor, or Assistant Editor.)

To educate the general public around the world on environmental issues, HJIFUS launched *The Earth & I* on Earth Day, April 22, 2021, via <u>theearthandi.org</u>. Since its launch, publications have been running every two months with 16 editorial sections on various environmental issues plus news and fact-based commentary. With the editorial team now expanding, this is a good opportunity for anyone who is aspiring to be a

professional journalist on the environment and to show why we must preserve nature. Although *The Earth* & *I* is currently free to read, we plan to market it and to ultimately generate funds for the Foundation.

Responsibilities: (1) Analytically research environmental topics and keep up to date with recent environmental trends and news, (2) Contribute toward the publication planning process, (3) Develop story ideas and pipelines, (4) Communicate with and set deadlines for story authors, (5) Collaborate with the editorial team, and (6) Work with the designer to complete the final publication product.
Expected competencies: (1) Have adept writing and editing skills, (2) Be clear and respectful to the authors and readers, (3) Be able to meet deadlines, and (4) Have a critical understanding on environmental issues.

Business/Marketing (Similar titles offered are Marketing Manager or Business Manager.)

- Responsibilities: (1) Define and reach the target market, (2) Analytically research strategies for increasing *The Earth & I* readership and revenue, (3) Assess strengths and weaknesses of competing periodicals, (4) Monitor marketing reactions and quotations rates, and (5) Ultimately bring financial success to the publication.
- Expected competencies: (1) Have up-to-date knowledge of commercial/marketing principles and (2) Experience in managing accounts on social networking platforms.
