Criteria for bringing guests:

• At least four studies with them. Hopefully by then, you have a good understanding of who they are and a good foundation/relationship with them.

• If they come to the 1 day workshop that CARP is hosting this Saturday from 10 am - 2 pm at the CARP house.

• If you still feel unsure if you want to bring your guests to this workshop, we want to Invite encourage you and your guests to come to this One Day workshop that we will be hosting this Saturday from 10 am - 2 pm at the CARP house. You will be able to see the kind of environment and workshop CARP runs and from there you can decide if you would like to invite them to the 7 day workshop.

Cost:

• **\$200** for full 7 days (21-28)

• \$150 for just 4 days (21-25) because it will be at the workshop site and it is expensive!

• **\$50 for the actionizing (26**-28) because it will be at the CARP house and the rest of the cost is supplemented by their fundraising.

• As much as possible we want to encourage guests to stay for the whole 7 days so they can experience the fullness of the workshop. But also, we encourage them to stay at the workshop site and not to go home with their own vehicles. We understand that guests have different situations

Workshop schedule:

• First four days will be focused on Divine Principle Lectures

 $\circ$  1st day: Principle of Creation, Fall, Restoration given by GPA CIG members

 2nd day: Mission of Messiah, 3 Families given by CARP member (Connor)

• 3rd day: Parallels, Second Advent given by Uncle Henri

• 4th day: True Parents' Life Course, Blessing Education by Uncle Larry and Pastor Highmy

• Along with the lectures, there will be an "action task" every day to match the lectures and goals for the day. The purpose behind these action tasks is to better understand the content of the lectures by doing activities related to it. For example, on the first day after guests receive POC and the Fall lecture, they will be writing a letter to God as a way to be vulnerable to Him.

## • Next 3 days will be "actionizing."

• 5th day: Fundraising. This fundraising is not like MFT or GPA style. It will be 2 one hour runs. The guests will be paired with a CARP member or someone experienced and will be very laid back. The purpose behind this fundraising is to practice working towards an internal goal and putting Principle into practice.

• 6th day: Camping. We will be going to Shenandoahs and be in the woods hiking and spending the evening camping. The purpose behind this

day is to completely immerse our**selves in God's creation and also spend** quality time as brothers and sisters.

• 7th day: Service work. This day will be focused on growing our hearts and spirit through giving back.

• The purpose behind this actionizing is to put DP into action. It's an adventure! It's meant to be a really fun experience for the guests and a time to make memories. For that sake, we want to ask for these three days that we keep the age range to be 16-30.

This would mean that many of your guests may be able to come without you being there. The reason for this is because we feel that having a very wide age range present can make the atmosphere different, and we will also be doing lots of hiking and adventurous things. We apologize, but for **the sake of the environment we're trying to create, it might be better if it's** just people of the same age for these three days.

For YA and spiritual parents of guests:

• There will be a couple young adults joining our workshop, most of them will be high school age. Since there will be guests at the workshop, we want to meet with all the YAs to explain beforehand how to behave around guests.

• Spiritual parents who will be joining the workshop, we ask that you can support in either kitchen staff role or just be there to support your guest. For the same reason as the actionizing, we want to keep the teams in the same age range for the sake of the environment and discussions, but you are more than welcome to listen to the lectures. There will be opportunities to connect to your own guests and other participants during meal times.

Covid guideline:

• Before coming to the workshop, you must test 3 days before and show a negative test result.

• During the workshop, we will check temperature every morning and do a health check.

• If someone does end up testing positive, they will be quarantined immediately in their own room and we will go into other protocols.

Outcome of the workshop:

- We want the guest to know that CARP is a place for growth.
- Commit to further studies and cultivate desire to learn more.
- Deepen and elevate our relationship with guests.
- For them to know who True Parents are.
