In observance of UN World Environment Day, we are featuring an exciting summit with expert speakers to awaken our consciousness and promote action in protecting and renewing our ecosystems. Dr. Sun Jin Moon, Executive Director of the Hyo Jeong International Foundation for Environmental Peace, will give the welcoming address followed by two well-known scientists who will speak on the theme of Rejuvenating Our Ecosystems.

- Dr. Rattan Lal, Distinguished University Professor of Soil Science, The Ohio State University, will speak on “Addressing the Problem of Land Degradation.”
