Elisabetta Nistri, President of WFPW Italy, was given a space on the online journal [www.dire.it](http://www.dire.it) to introduce WFPW's vision and mission. Mrs. Nistri concisely introduced WFPW to the public readers, offering a brief glimpse into WFPW's history and work.

She started by saying that it was founded in 1992, in South Korea, by Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon and her husband, aiming to help women realize their value and obtain their rightful recognition. She continued by clarifying that it has since been expanding throughout the world to promote women as an essential ingredient in creating, alongside men, a culture of peace.



Regarding WFPW in Italy, she specified it was first legally registered in Rome in 1998 and, to this day, it also operates in Turin, Bergamo, Padua and Caserta.

Finally, she mentioned a few of the activities carried out by WFPW Italy. The celebration of ONU international days in cooperation with local, regional, and national institutions. The humanitarian help projects in Nepal, Jordan, and the Philippines, intended to support women and children especially. Its collaboration with local schools and the promotion of public events. Its interventions on various topics such as the dignity of women and peace education.

Lastly, she announced that, due to Covid-19, the conference titled "The Role of Women in International Diplomacy: To Build a Lasting Peace" at the European Parliament office in Rome had been postponed to 6 May 2020.
