WFWP Italy - The Feminine Value from Its Origin to Today: Where Are We?

On 25th September 2020, WFWP Italy held a meeting entitled: "The Feminine Value From Its Origins To Today: Where Are We?" sponsored by WFWP International and moderated by Maria Gabriella Mieli, Vice President of WFWP Italy.

The main themes have been related to the value of femininity, and are in line with the SDG objectives of the UN 2030 Agenda, in particular No. 3: Health and Welfare for

all, and No. 5: Gender Equality. The speeches of the two speakers were very interesting: Elisabetta Nistri, President WFWP Italy and Onorina Gibi, Psychotherapist and Family Therapist.



Dr. Nistri, introducing the keynote speaker, quoted WFWP International Founder, Hak Ja Han Moon, who had founded this organisation precisely with the aim of reconnecting women to their original divine femininity from the Creator. Just as the Bible says in Genesis, every woman represents the feminine aspect of Mother God, and every man reflects the masculine aspect of Father God.

Starting from this awareness, women and men together can solve the urgent problems that our world is facing; only if women cease their silence, by no longer standing behind men, but rather by their side, can men and women be made more complete in a partnership relationship, thus playing the fundamental role

of Peace Activists.

President Elisabetta Nistri then invited all those interested to participate in the upcoming Rally of Hope <u>#Rallyofhope</u> that Dr. Moon organised live with the world, and with the participation of religious leaders, Heads of State, scientists and journalists, to collaborate together on the resolution of problems and the realization of peace.

Dr. Gibi then shifted the focus to nature, starting with symbolic images of femininity, such as the land, the sea and the moon, to remember the connection that all women have with nature.



Citing the famous psychologist C. G. Jung, she then revealed the secret of personal completeness: the right balance between animus and soul in man and woman, where animus indicates the rational, logical, orderly, masculine component, and with soul the instinctive, emotional, loving, feminine component.

The current problem of many young women who are losing sight of true beauty, that of the heart, has also been addressed, where women today focus on an ephemeral and superficial beauty that makes them into "soulless dolls" - interchangeable, fragile, insecure and misused.

True friendship and true love, in fact, stressed Dr. Gibi, aren't self-seeking, and they do not come about through victimization; rather they come from knowing how to distribute one's vital energy to another. Only starting from self-love and awareness of one's own worth is it really possible to help others. And to do this, it is necessary to look within yourself

and understand what the inner obstacles, false beliefs, and clichés are, which prevent self-love from blossoming.

The meeting ended with a question-and-answer session between the participants and speakers, in which the topics were further explored, and with a video showing the art of mandala.

The meeting garnered great interest and saw the participation of about 100 people on Zoom live and about 490 views on the WFWP Italy Facebook page. The event on Facebook could reach altogether 1751 contacts.
