UPF and IAAP Tirana, Albania's Second International Conference on the Family

Tirana, Albania -- Approximately 100 people attended the second International Conference on the Family.

Like the first conference in November 2022, the second conference was titled "Family, Society and Universal Values."

The event on April 15, 2023, was organized by the Albanian chapters of UPF and its International Association of Academicians for Peace (IAAP).

More than 60 dignitaries, researchers from various fields, Ambassadors for Peace and young people gathered in the Tirana Peace Embassy, with about 40 more joining online. The speakers were from Albania, Kosovo, Serbia, North Macedonia and France.



H.E. Fatmir Sejdiu, the former president of Kosovo (2006-2010), delivered the welcoming speech.

"Understanding the Family as a School of Love. How Can the Difficulties in Family Functioning Be Overcome?" by **Jacques Marion**, the co-chair of UPF for Europe and the Middle East;



"Family Values and the Process of Selection and Transmission from One Generation to Another. Models and Alternatives" by **Professor Dr. Lekë Sokoli**, director of the Institute of Sociology, Albania.
