

Round table on "Dialogue of cultures: different traditions - common goals"

The round table on "Dialogue of Cultures: Different Traditions - Common Goals" in the framework of the UN World Interfaith Harmony Week, on the initiative of the Universal Peace Federation in St. Petersburg, with participation of the local Jewish community, was held at the Jewish Community Center on February 2.



Boris Slivkin, head of the youth movement "Maccabi" told the meeting participants about the large-scale activities of the Jewish community in the field of sports development, as well as interfaith dialogue.



Ambassador for Peace, head of the community, Vadim Polyansky, answered questions of the guests, among which were students from different countries, of different confessional affiliation. Young people were interested in peculiarities of the traditions and culture of Jewish people, as well as in the public activities of the community.

Natalia Chigrina, head of the north-western chapter of the Universal Peace Federation, shared about the movement of Ambassadors for Peace, experience in establishing an interreligious dialogue, cooperation, developing social and philanthropic projects of the Universal Peace Federation.
