

# Ancestral Memorial Day in Estonia

*Estonia, Olga Martinson, November 1, 2018*



On the first day of November, Estonian FFWPU leaders Avo and Olga Martinson made a spiritual condition, timed to the day of the commemoration of their ancestors - the Day of All Souls.

They visited the graves of people in the spiritual world who had previously been freed and blessed. These are seven people who have played an important role in the history of Estonia. Among them was the first president of Estonia, the president at the time of independence, poets, patriots, the founder of the Singing Field and an Ambassador of Peace who until her death actively supported the activities of UPF.



Avo and Olga consecrated the graves with Holy Salt, laid flowers, lit candles, read the words of True Mother, and prayed for these people. They included recordings of songs composed by them, the Estonian anthem.

They prayed for the release of these people in the spiritual world, so that they will help in carrying out the mission of Heavenly Tribal Messiahship and searching for people like John the

Baptist. The woman who was cleaning the grave nearby was very much inspired by the ceremony.

Mr. and Mrs. Martinson have gained a deep experience of heart through this condition. Praying earnestly near each grave, they were able to sense the gratitude of these historical figures, who were touched by the attention shown. Olga shared her feelings: "I am not an Estonian, but I did not feel a spiritual barrier, feeling that we are all one family in the center with God and True Parents."
