This notice is to let you know of the new special purpose International Pioneer Academy which began this Fall in the city of San Francisco. The purpose of this academy is to develop the conscience and mind of men and women who have the desire and potential to be leaders in effecting constructive social change in the world.

The curriculum is designed to meet these needs and may be examined in the accompanying brochure. Special features of this new academy include: 1) leadership development, 2) social regeneration programs, 3) work-study programs, 4) life education in residence. Classes are in the morning with some additional classes in the evening for those who can't attend the morning sessions.

Through these programs, the education will be most relevant and meaningful because of its responsiveness to the needs of society today.


Upon completion of the program, graduates will be well prepared for: 1) leadership, 2) more specialized area studies, 3) community development programs, 4) international programs and agencies (e.g., the Peace Corps), 5) International Re-Education Foundation programs which are in the Alternative Service Program for conscientious objectors to the military, 6) citizenship in the International Ideal City Project.

Professors come from nine different nations. Some are: Dr. R. Gordon Agnew, Prof. Emeritus of Pathology, U.C. Medical Center; Dr. William O'Neil, Philosophy, University of Liverpool; Dr. Framroze A. Bode, World Religion, California Institute of Asian Studies; and Dr. John P. Troxell, Prof. Emeritus of Economics, Stanford University.

Library facilities are available in the academy with a specialized communications library and also through cooperating institutions here in San Francisco.
